- What is one moment from Pentecost Sunday that impacted you personally?

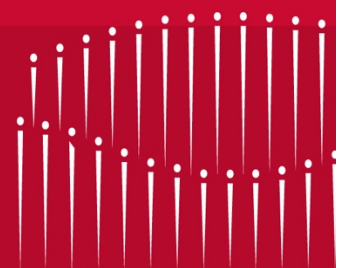
### PRAISE & WORSHIP

Ask two people to read the key scriptures for tonight:

- **John 3:5-6 (Scripture context: Jesus explains that spiritual life comes through being born of the Spirit. Salvation is not external religion, but a spiritual transformation through the Holy Spirit.)**
- **Acts 1:8 (Scripture context: Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will come upon believers with power so they can become bold witnesses and advance God's Kingdom.)**

Let's unpack these two scriptures by asking the following questions:

Why do you think many believers understand salvation, but struggle to walk in the power and purpose of the Holy Spirit?

- *Many believers understand receiving Jesus as Saviour, but were never taught that the Holy Spirit also empowers us for **purpose and assignment**. Some people become comfortable in Christianity without stepping into boldness, serving, leadership, witnessing, or spiritual growth.*

What stood out to you about the difference between the Holy Spirit within us and the Holy Spirit upon us?

- *The message highlighted two dimensions:  
**Within us** → Salvation, relationship, character, assurance  
**Upon us** → Power, boldness, effectiveness, assignment*
- *The Holy Spirit within us makes us children of God. The Holy Spirit upon us empowers us to impact others and build God's Kingdom.*
- ***God did not only save us from something – He saved us for something.***

Pastor Louis said the Holy Spirit within us is **the seal that we belong to God**. How does that truth bring confidence and assurance in your daily life?

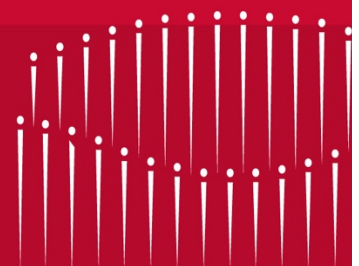
- *Many Christians struggle with insecurity, guilt, fear, or condemnation. But the Holy Spirit is God's confirmation that we belong to Him.*

Acts 1:8 says we receive power to **become witnesses**. What does being a witness for Jesus look like practically in today's world?

- *Being a witness is not only preaching behind a pulpit.*
- *God uses ordinary people in everyday places.*

The message taught that the anointing is **connected to assignment**. What assignment or purpose do you believe God is calling you to step into?

- *The anointing is not for status or recognition. It is empowerment for purpose.*
- *Do not compare yourself to others. Purpose may look different for each person.*

Why is it important to have both character and power operating together in the life of a believer?

- The message emphasized:  
**Within** → Character & fruit  
**Upon** → Power & gifts
- Power without character can become dangerous.
- Character without boldness can become passive.

Jesus Himself ministered under the **anointing of the Holy Spirit**. What does that teach us about our dependence on God?

- If Jesus relied on the Holy Spirit, how much more do we need Him?

**Read 1 Thessalonians 5:19**

**What are some ways believers can unintentionally quench or neglect the work of the Holy Spirit?**

This message challenged us not to settle for just “surviving” Christianity. What does living an **empowered Christian life** look like to you?

- *Be encouraged today to dream again spiritually.*

Ask yourself tonight, what is one practical area where you want to become more sensitive to the **leading and empowering of the Holy Spirit** this week?
