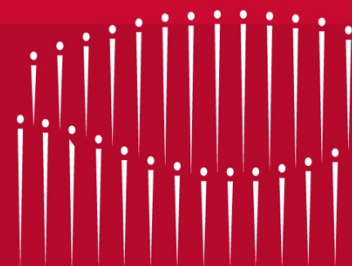

## ENGAGE – THE WORD

**Let us get the members comfortable and connecting, ask these opening questions:**

- What stood out from last week's sermon?
- What is something Pastor said that you have started implementing already?

**Psalm 126:3 (NKJV), says:**

**"The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad."**

- Psalm 126:3 reminds us that God has already done great things for us, but do we truly recognize them, or have we become so focused on what's missing that we overlook what He's already done?
- Ask the members: Are we living with a mindset of joy and gratitude, or are we waiting for the next breakthrough before we choose to be glad?

**Get someone to read: Ecclesiastes 3:4**

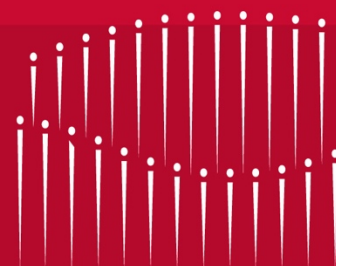
- What are some "great things" God has done in your life recently that you haven't fully celebrated yet?
- What does true, deep thankfulness look like in your daily life?
- Looking at this season we've come through, what part required your discipline and effort, and how did you see God bless it?
- After reaching a "mountaintop moment" (like building, achieving, or breakthrough), how do you personally answer the question: "What now?"
- Ecclesiastes says there's a time to celebrate, do you find it easy or difficult to pause and celebrate what God has done? Why?

**Closing remarks:**

- We are still people of faith, people of discipline, people of evangelism, and people of discipleship. That hasn't changed. In fact, this season should strengthen who we are, not slow us down.
