Let us discuss the following:

- Right now, what is actually “in your hand” that you’ve been overlooking or calling “not enough”?
- How has comparing yourself to others, stopped you from moving forward?
- Think of a past moment when God used something simple or small in your life to do something powerful. What was “in your hand” then, and what happened when you gave it to Him?

Pastor mentioned 10 things that you might have in your hands that are the staff in your hand:

1. A skill you think is “too small”

- Cooking, listening, organizing, writing emails, fixing things, whatever feels ordinary.
- Question: What do you do well that you’ve disqualified because “anybody can do it”?

2. A relationship or connection you already have

- That friend, co-worker, neighbour, or family member God has placed near you.
- Question: Who is already in your life that God might want to use to open a door or to bless through you?

3. A resource that feels too little

- Question: What do you keep saying “When I have more...” about, instead of offering it now?

4. An opportunity that looks too simple

- The open invitation, the small request, the “boring” task nobody wants.
- Question: What feels beneath you or too easy that might actually be God’s starting point?

5. A passion burning in your heart

- That thing you can’t stop thinking or talking about.
- Question: What stirs you deeply even if you think it’s silly or impossible?

6. A word God has already spoken to you

- A promise, a Scripture, an instruction you heard clearly.
- Question: What has God told you to do that you’re still waiting to feel “ready” for?

7. **Your story**

- The pain, failure, or victory nobody else has lived, your testimony.
- Question: Which part of your testimony do you hide that could set someone else free (**Revelation 12:11**)?

8. **Something you complain about daily**

- The job you hate, the church you criticize, the season you wish was over.
- Question: What are you envying in someone else's life while overlooking the gift in yours?

9. **A character trait others overlook**

- Your patience, kindness, consistency, loyalty, or quiet faithfulness.
- Question: What quality in you do people depend on that you take for granted?

10. **Your current season**

- The waiting, the wilderness, the preparation nobody sees.
- Question: How might God be using exactly where you are right now to equip you for where He's taking you?

WORKS & APPLICATION

Encourage members to share personal testimonies of times when God came through against all odds when the situation seemed hopeless, the diagnosis was grim, but God stepped in and turned everything around.

Allow these moments to foster a supportive environment where the group can join hands and pray together for those facing challenges, drawing strength from Revelation 12:11 that says: And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

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
