- If the Church is God's heart, dwelling, and strategy not man's idea what do you think He wants to do through us in this second wave of love?
- What is something that Pastor said on Sunday that you have always known, but has gotten a whole new meaning ever since you heard it on Sunday?

## **Let us discuss the points that Pastor mentioned on Sunday:**

1. The House of God is a public Holy Gathering.

Get a few people to read: Psalm 122:1, 1 Corinthians 6:19, Ephesians 2:19 & Hebrews 10:25

- What is the meaning of corporate gathering?
- What makes you glad to come gather publicly with the family of God?
- Can you think of a time God did something powerful only because we gathered as one?
- How does coming together change things compared to just your personal time with God?

2. God's fire falls where people gather in unity.

Get a few people to read: Acts 2:1, Acts 2:5-6 & Genesis 3:28

- What does "one accord" look like for us today to see fresh Pentecost fire?
- Look around: different races, cultures, rich and poor in one room. Why is this so powerful?

3. The House of God is honoured through holy time and first fruit.

Read: Isaiah 58:13-14

- What does it personally mean to you to honour God by giving Him the "first" of your week your time, energy, or focus?
- Can you share a time when putting God first on His day brought unexpected joy or breakthrough in your life?

## 4. The House of God planned, ordered and built with intent.

Get a few people to read: Matthew 16:18, Ephesians 2:20 & 1 Corinthians 3:11

- What does it mean in your daily life to let Jesus be the true Cornerstone aligning your worship, words, and choices with Him?
- How have you seen Jesus stay the unchanging Cornerstone even when churches look or feel very different from each other?
- Why do you think God allows different worship styles, preaching emphases, and church cultures as long as Jesus remains the foundation?
- Can you share an example from your own experience where a church or leader helped you align more closely with Jesus as the Cornerstone?
- The Cornerstone never changes, but the house can look different. How does that truth make you feel about our Homecell?

## 5. The House of God is a family.

Get a few people to read: Ephesians 2:19, Psalm 92:13 & 1 Corinthians 12:18

- What does being part of God's family mean to you?
- Can you share one way this Homecell has already felt like real family to you (care, relationship, or growth)?
- Psalm 92 says those planted in God's house flourish. What helps you stay planted instead of just visiting?
- Turn to someone near you and say: "God planted me here, and I'm glad you're in this family too!" How does that feel?

## 6. The House of God is a place of God's presence and encounter.

Read: Genesis 28:16-17

- Jacob said, "Surely the Lord is in this place... this is the house of God!" Have you ever felt God's presence so strongly here that it changed something in you?
