CRC Bible School Short Courses

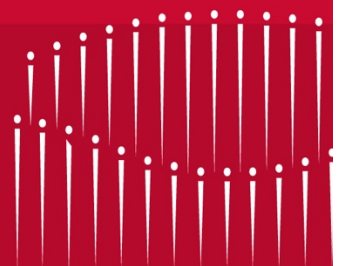
- Join our 8-week Bible courses, held once a week on Tuesdays and aligned with the public school terms. Each course is presented online and accessible from across the world.

PRAISE & WORSHIP

Sing at least 1 dynamic praise song and 2 intimate worship songs. As leaders, we set the pace for Praise & Worship, led by example and with confidence!

ENGAGE – THE WORD

Read the following scripture and ask these questions to get the conversation flowing:

Read: 2 Corinthians 4:13 "It is written: 'I believed; therefore I have spoken.' Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak".

- *Last Sunday, we heard: "Your mouth is not the problem. Your belief system is." What does this mean to you?*
- *In what ways do you notice your words being shaped more by how you see yourself than by your actual abilities or circumstances?*

"You don't speak small because of your personality... You speak small because of what you believe about yourself."

1. **Pastor highlighted that many young people (and many of us) are not struggling with ability — they are struggling with identity. Let's expose the lie of 'not being good enough' tonight.**
 - *What does the lie sound like in your own life?*
 - *The lies can sound like: 'I'm not good enough', 'I'm average', 'others are better than me', or 'I will never be like them'. Do these lies sound familiar to you?*
 - *What do you think these lies produce?*
 - *These lies produce insecurity, comparison, fear of stepping out, and not taking big risks (playing it small in life).*

Read: Proverbs 23:7a "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he".

“You can have potential... but if you believe you are not enough, you will talk yourself out of every opportunity God gives you.”

- *Can you relate to the statements above? (No need to share details if uncomfortable, just reflect.)*
- *How have your beliefs about yourself affected the way you speak about your future, your calling, or your abilities?*

Imagine someone gives you a brand-new Ferrari, but you believe you're not a good driver. You'll drive slowly, hesitate, and never fully use what you have. The problem is not the car, it's what you believe about yourself.

2. You need to uproot the lie and replant the truth, “If God made you... Then you are not lacking, you are designed.” You are not trying to become enough — you already are, because God made you.

- *Where do you think the “I am not enough” belief often comes from? (People’s words, social media, comparison, past failures, etc.)*
- *When your belief changes, your words will change. In which area of your life do you most need this shift right now?*
- *In what area of your life do you need to remind yourself that failure is not final and the pit is not your identity?*

As we conclude, let us discuss your belief system and your words.

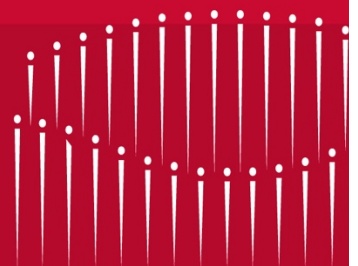
Get a few people to read: Psalm 139:14, Ephesians 2:10, Romans 8:37 & Romans 10:10

- *What is one belief you may need to change so your words and life align with God's truth?*

Ask everyone to identify (silently or quietly) one negative sentence they often say about themselves (e.g., "I'm not good enough", "I'm shy", "I'll never succeed"). Then say: "Today — that lie ends."

Lead them in this Declaration (speak slowly and with authority, have them repeat after you, and stand if possible):

"I am created by God.

I am not average.

I am not lacking.

I am enough.

I am chosen.

I am called.

I am designed with purpose.

I will not speak small about my life.

I believe differently - so I will speak differently."

Closing Prayer

Pray together for identity restoration and boldness to speak God's truth over our lives.
