The Church - the Body of Christ

Ephesians 1:22-23 ²² And He subjected all things under His feet and gave <u>Him to be Head</u> over all things to <u>the church, ²³ which is His Body</u>, the fullness of the One who fills all in all.

Genesis 2:21-24 ²¹ And Jehovah God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh in its place. ²² And Jehovah God built the rib, which He had taken from the man, into a woman and brought her to the man. ²³ And the man said, This time this is bone of my bones / And flesh of my flesh; / This one shall be called Woman / Because out of Man this one was taken. ²⁴ Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and shall cleave to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

Ephesians 5:25,31-32 ²⁵Husbands, love your wives even as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her. ³¹For this cause a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall be one flesh. ³²This mystery is great, but I speak with regard to Christ and the church.

The Riches of Christ and the Fullness of Christ

Ephesians 3:8 To me, less than the least of all saints, was this grace given to announce to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ as the gospel.

3:10 - In order that now to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenlies the multifarious wisdom of God might be made known through the church,

3:11 - According to the eternal purpose which He made in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The Body is Christ

1 Corinthians 12:12 For even as the body is one and has many members, yet all the members of the body, being many, are one body, so also is the Christ.

Colossians 3:11 Where there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all and in all.

1:18 The eyes of your heart having been enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,
