



Day 2: The Freedom Found in Christ and in God's Design

KNOW IT!

Galatians 5:13-15

For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another.

Romans 3:23-24

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

We have all sinned and fallen short of God's glory, yet through Christ, we are freely justified. Spend time reflecting on your own need for salvation. How does recognizing your sin make Christ's sacrifice more meaningful? This is a truth that your eternal life depends on and that leads to being set free to be whom He designed you to be. True freedom isn't found in doing whatever we want, but in living as God designed us to live. Consider how our culture often confuses autonomy with freedom. How does God's law actually lead to greater freedom? Thank God for His incredible gift of grace and ask Him to help you live in light of that grace today.
