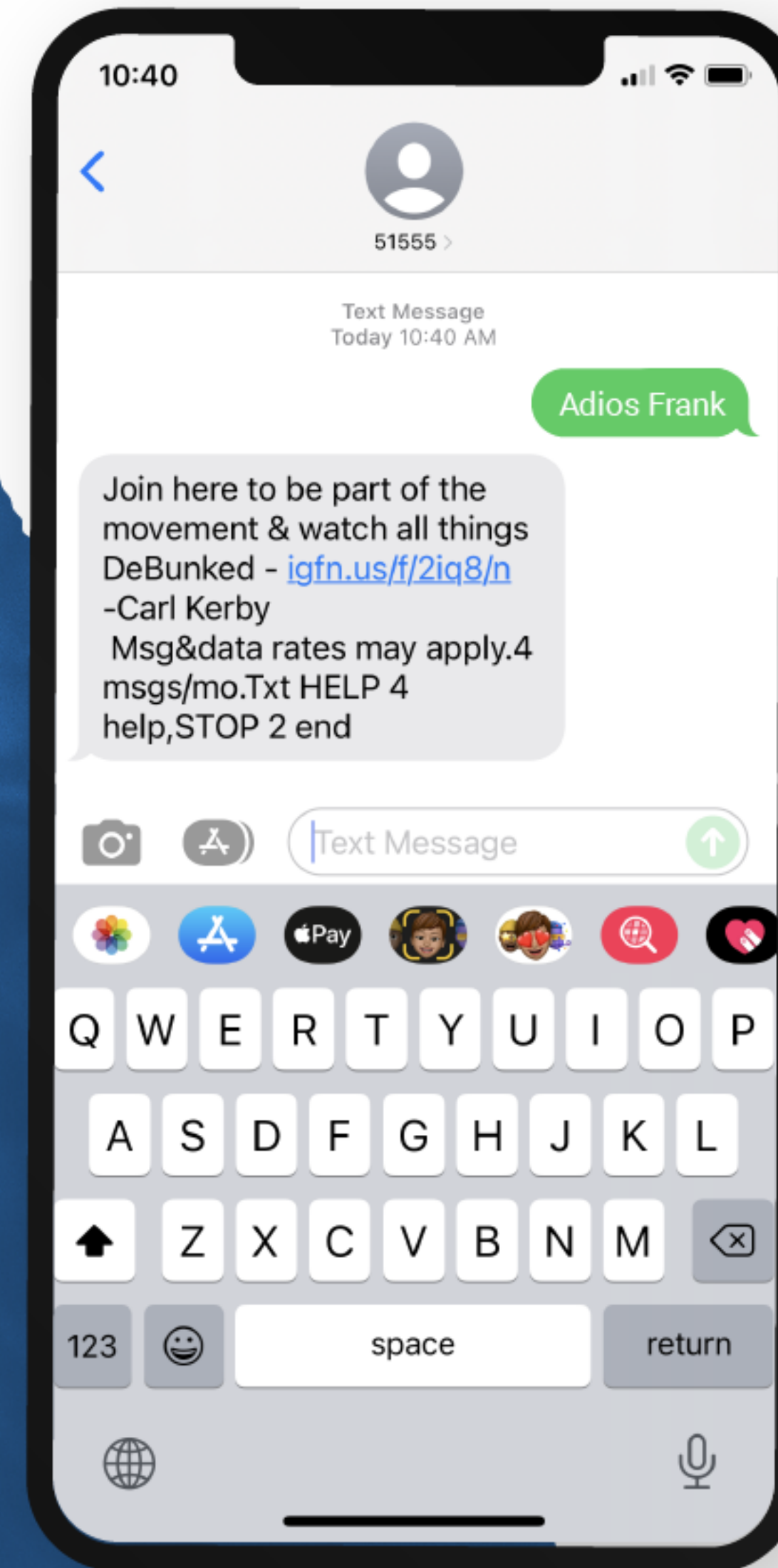

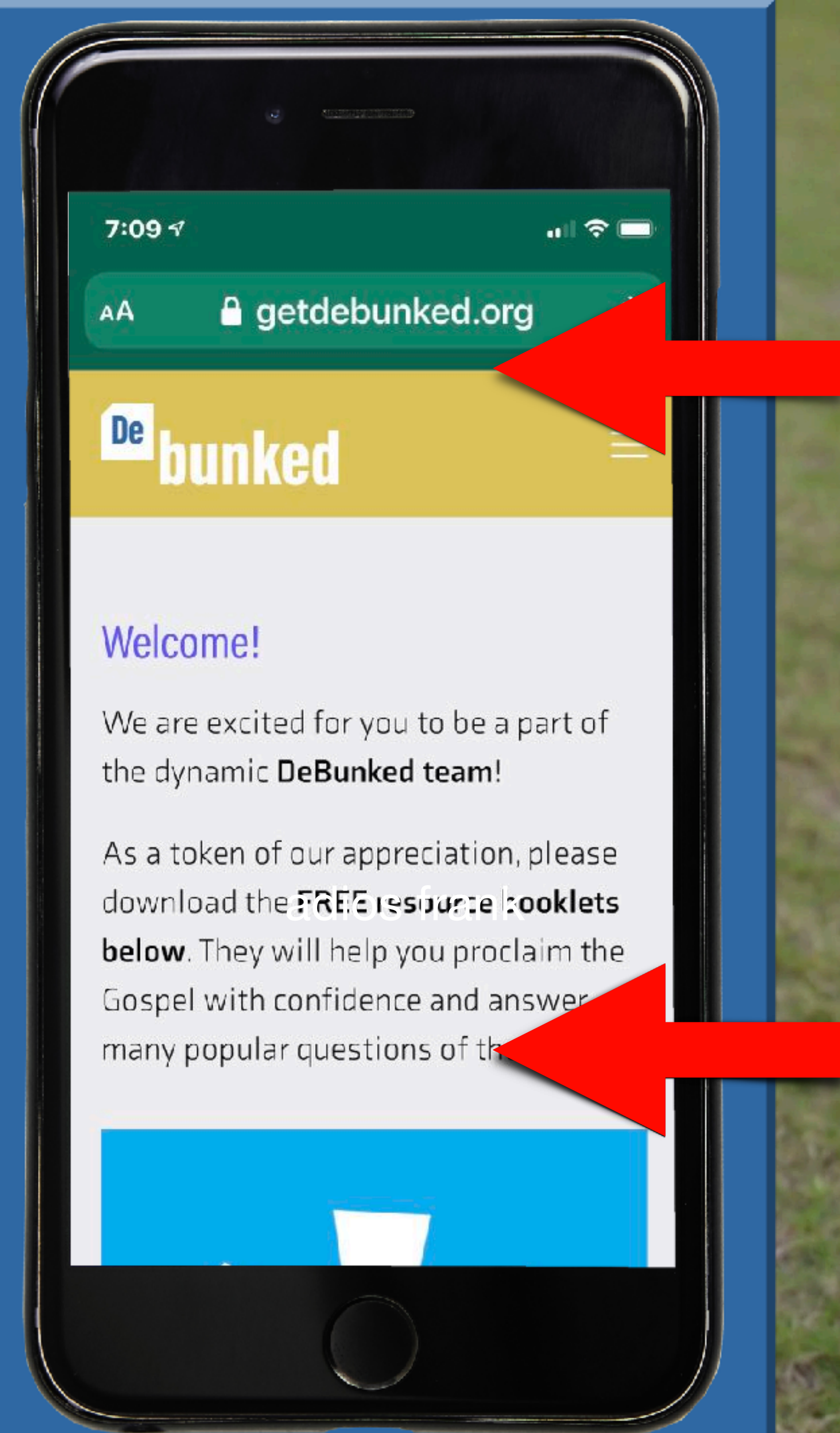



The patient was treated with radiation therapy and is unable to return to work/childcare until 4/9/20.


After a medical visit to return to work, she may require rest throughout the day



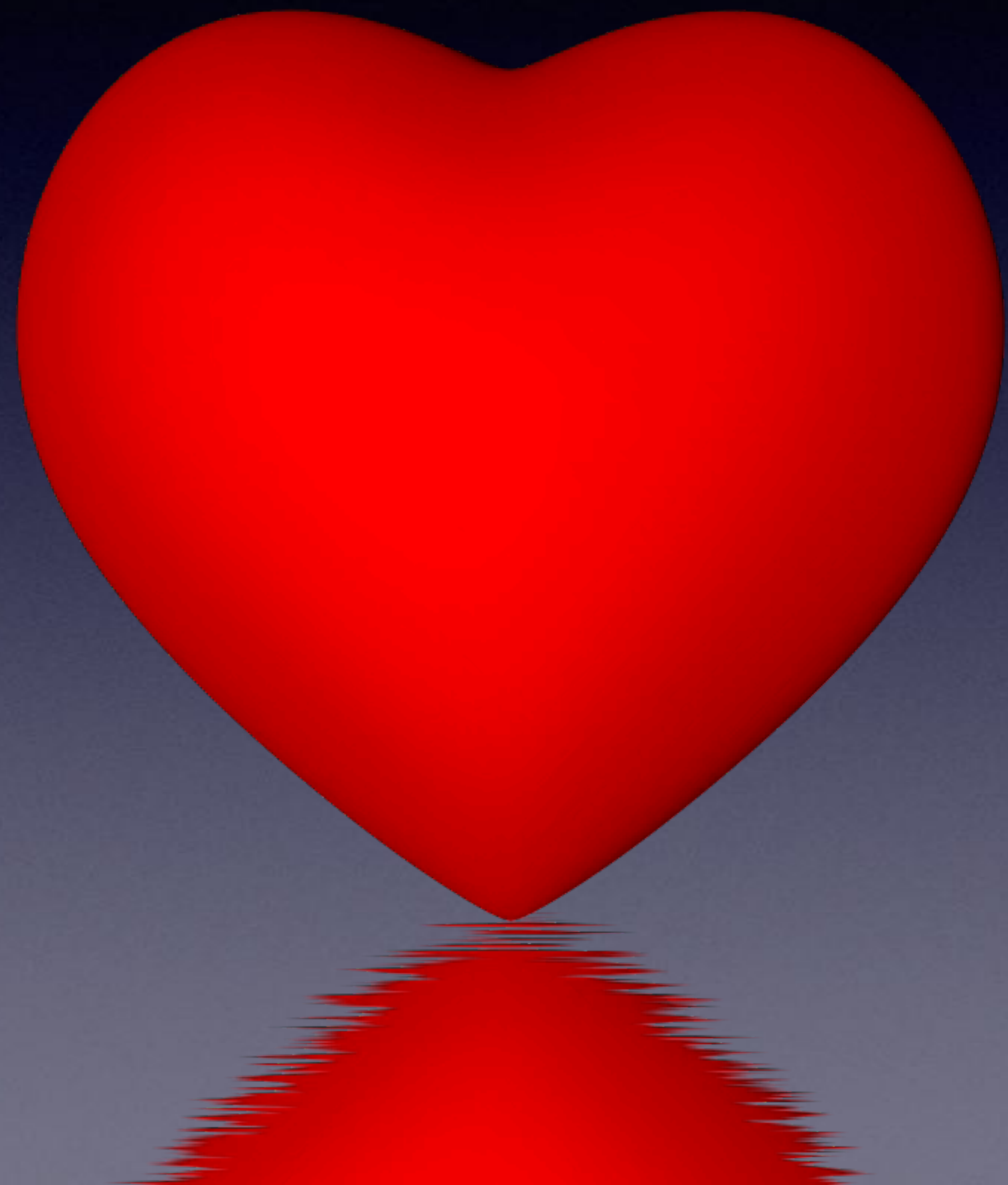

The Book of Psalms was gradually collected and originally unnamed, perhaps due to the great variety of material. It came to be known as *Sepher Tehillim*—"Book of Praises"—because almost every psalm contains some note of praise to God. The Septuagint uses the Greek word *Psalmoi* as its title for this book, meaning poems sung to the accompaniment of musical instruments. It also calls it the *Psalterium* ("a collection of songs"), and this word is the basis for the term *Psalter*. The Latin title is *Liber Psalmorum*, "Book of Psalms."

THE AUTHOR OF PSALMS

 Although critics have challenged the historical accuracy of the superscriptions regarding authorship, the evidence is strongly in their favor. Almost half (seventy-three) of the psalms are designated as Davidic: 3—9; 11—32; 34—41; 51—65; 68—70; 86; 101; 103; 108—110; 122; 124; 131; 133; and 138—145. David's wide experience as shepherd, musician, warrior, and king (1011–971 B.C.) is reflected in these psalms. The New Testament reveals that the anonymous psalms 1 and 95 were also written by this king whose name means "Beloved of Yahweh" (Acts 13:36, 42). In addition to the superscriptions,

centuries. As individual psalms were used in Israel's small collections were included in the pilgrimage songs and psalms (1—41, 51—70, 138). Anthologies were gradually collected. The last stage was the compilation of the five books (Psalms 1—150). Hezekiah (2 Chr. 23:1–31), Ezra (Neh. 8) were involved in collecting the psalms. David's role in the temple liturgy of worship is also part. The superscriptions specify key events in his life: 59; 21:11 (Ps. 56); 142; 22:9 (Ps. 52); 23:1 (Ps. 23); Second Samuel 8:13 (Ps. 18); (Ps. 3); 15:23 (Ps. 63); 18).

Here are four things to keep in mind when interpreting the psalms: (1) The historical events are interpreted in that light. There is little hope in re-creating the original occasion. Assuming more than help the interpretation of the psalms are...

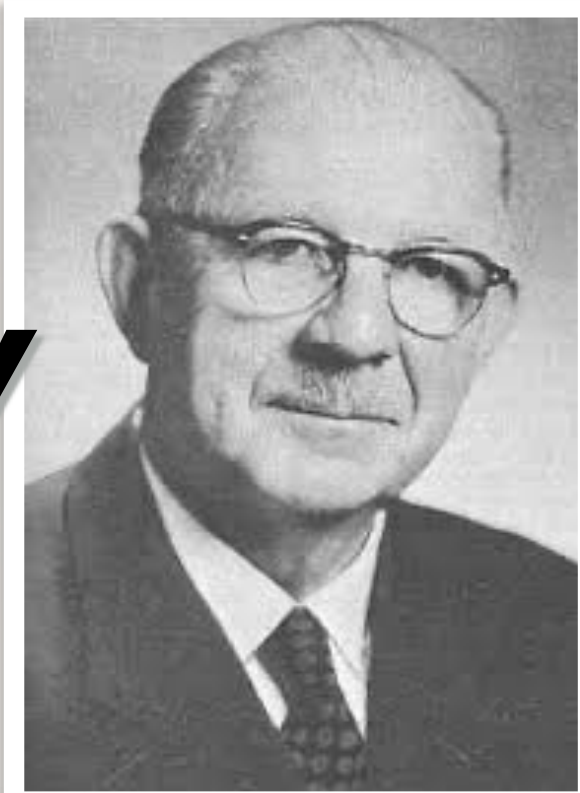

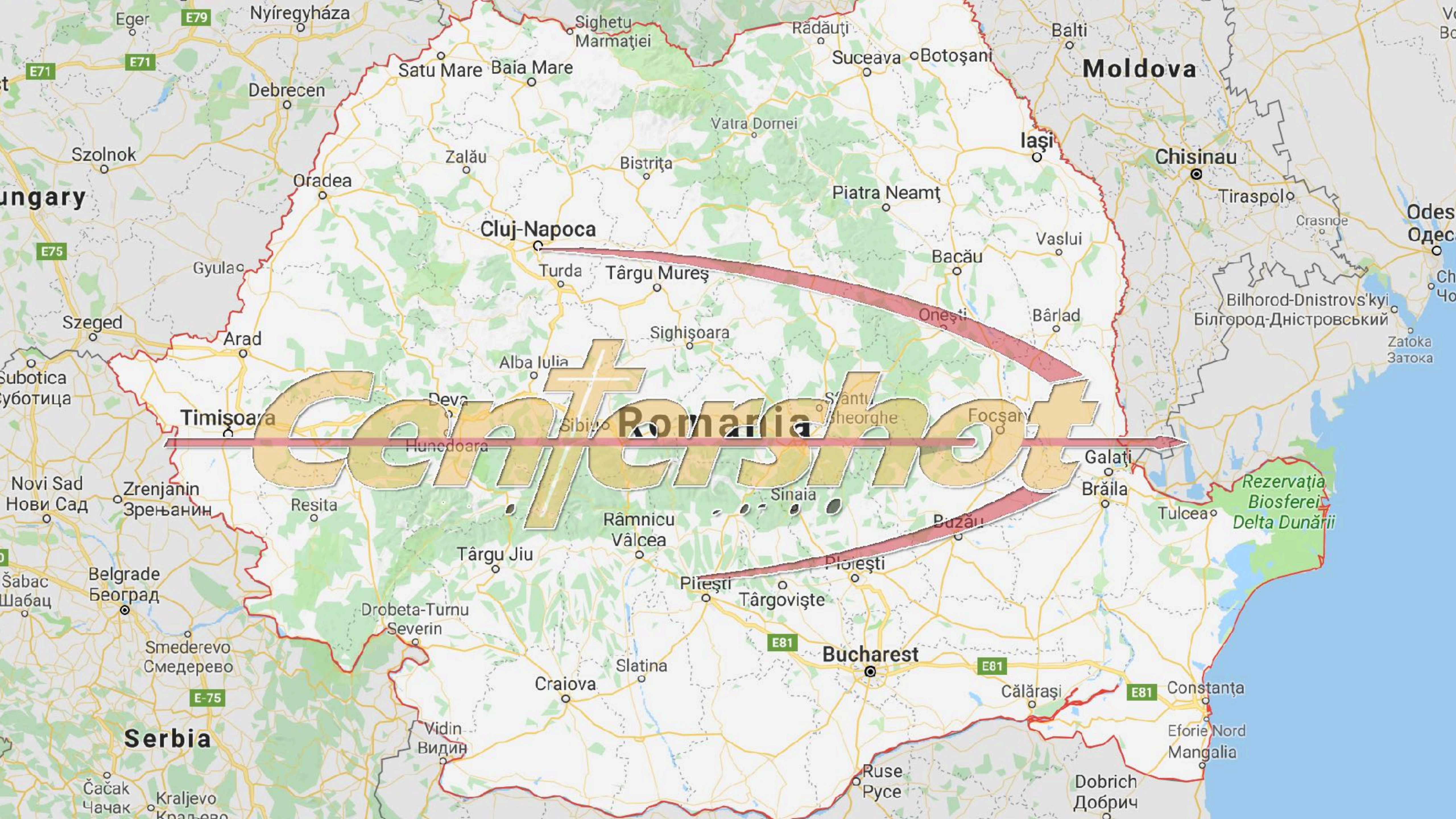

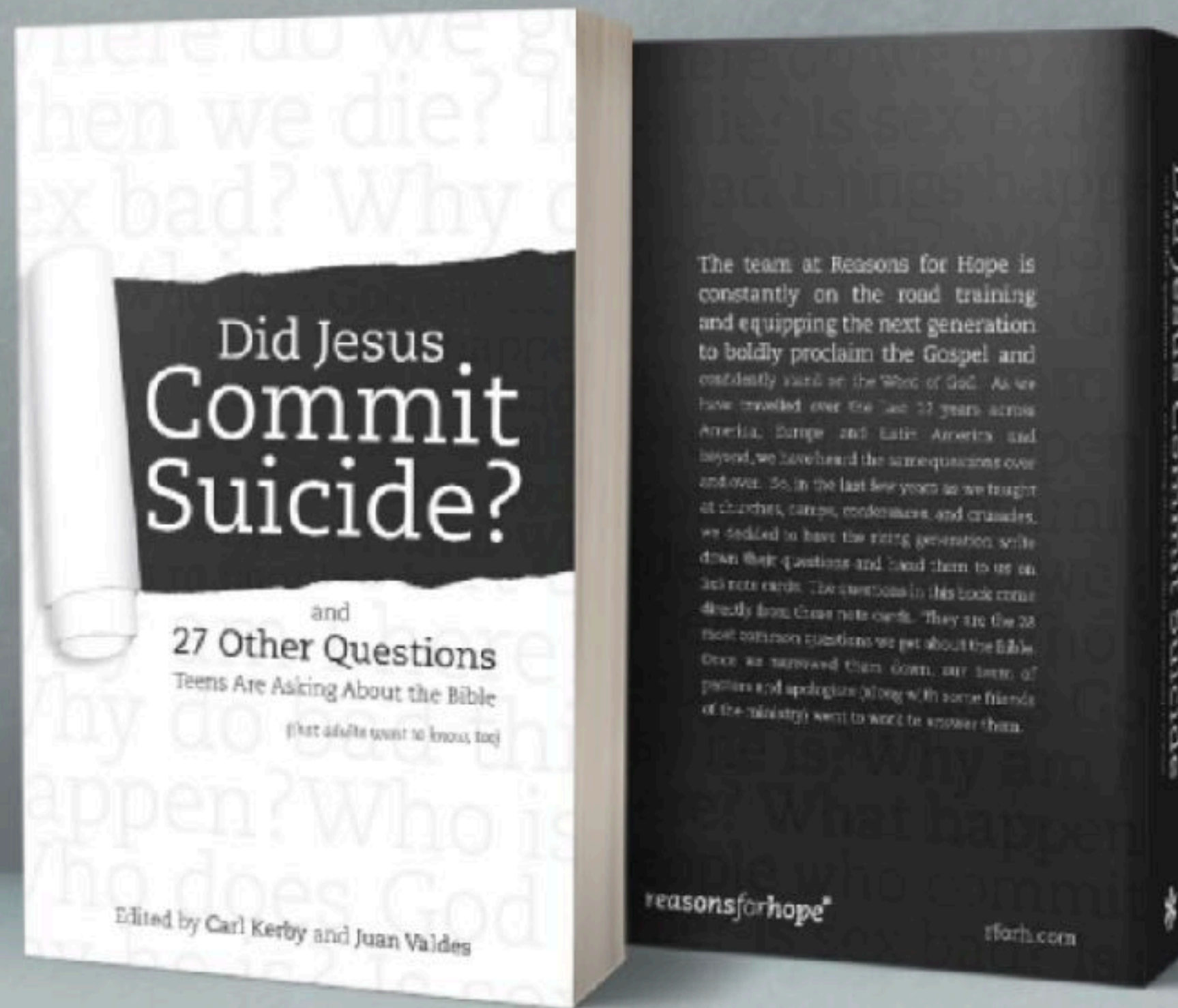
