KNOW IT!

John 11:25 (Context: John 11:1-21)

"Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live.'"

1 Corinthians 15:52-53 (Context: 1 Corinthians 15:50-58)

"In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality."

The truth of the Resurrection demands a response. If Jesus truly rose from the dead, then He is who He claimed to be—the Son of God, our Savior, and Lord. Are you living in the power of His Resurrection?
