



Day 5: Redeeming the Time

Know it!

Ephesians 5:15-17

Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

James 1:5

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

Paul exhorts us to "make the most of every opportunity" (Ephesians 5:16), while James promises God generously gives wisdom to those who ask. In the context of apologetics and sharing our faith, these verses remind us of the urgency and importance of our mission. Each day presents opportunities to share God's love and truth with others. Reflect on the opportunities God has placed in your life. Are there conversations you've been avoiding or questions you've been hesitant to address?

Live it! Share it!

- Ask God for the wisdom and courage to engage meaningfully with others about your faith. Pray for discernment to recognize divine appointments and for the grace to approach each interaction with love, humility, and biblical wisdom.

- Are there areas where you've conformed to the world rather than being transformed by the renewing of your mind? Pray for courage and wisdom to live out your faith authentically, drawing others to Christ through both your words and your actions.
