The Gospel of Luke: Crazy Love

1. Jesus is Invited to Dinner (7:36-39)

A. The Setting – the dinner; people reclined, feet (dirty) far from table; time for high conversation; talk of spiritual issues, issues in the gov't and country; many would come to listen, some beggars for food B. The Pharisee – his disdain and hatred for Jesus (trying to trap Him), and for the woman (vs.39)
C. The Woman (don't know her name, not the Mary who put perfume on Jesus' head, different story)

she is a sinner, term for most despised, NOT welcome– ______ breach of social customs
she brings an alabaster vial (Egyptian marble) of perfume – very expensive, costly to her
she <u>notices</u> Jesus' feet are dirty – rains down her tears, weeping, sobbing over being forgiven
she lets ______ her hair – required to keep hair up; this was shameful, woman could be divorced for this – she is wiping and drying His feet with her hair (*socially, a woman's glory*)
she continually kisses His feet – kissing, hugging, embracing His feet, then pours out perfume
Jesus – allows her to do this; it's an act of love and worship from her and then, Jesus, in His love for Simon, is going to use it as an arrow of conviction right to his heart – so He tells him a parable...

B. Jesus' Question – Which one loves Me/God more?

1. The _____ love of the woman and the _____ of Simon the Pharisee (religious) **vs.44-46* *Simon you gave Me no water for My feet, no kiss of greeting/respect, no anointing *This was a total disdain, slander and disgrace towards Jesus

*Woman – she noticed My dirty feet and washed and dried them with her tears and hair; she embraced and kissed My feet and wiped them with her hair

*she gave her most valuable possession to put on His feet. ***2Cor5:14-15

2. The _____ of sin owed to God (vs.47)

*the woman's humility and gratitude – she saw the depth of her sin before God and had been forgiven – vs.48 – Gk. perfect tense, have been in the past with continuing result in the present and future; *remember Luke6:20-21 ! *shows already saved (vs.50)
*she did all that she did (crazy love!) <u>because</u> she was forgiven – it was all for love and gratitude to Jesus for what He had done – this is the fruit of a transformed life!!!
*Simon's pride – he thought he was righteous and acceptable to God; I'm a good person!
*Luke6:24-26; Matt23:12-15,25,27-28,33 – who is the worst here?!!!

- C. The crazy love of Jesus!
 - Our debt of sin to God what are the <u>2 KEYS</u> in seeing the greatness of the love of God?!!! *to see the greatness and majesty of who He is (woman vs. Simon) **Is6:3; Ex33:18-23* *to see the depth and depravity of our sin!!! **Rom3:10-12,23; Is.59:2; 64:6*
 - 2. Have you seen the depth of your sin and depravity before God? Or, are you a Simon?
 - 3. Jesus will forgive much, for He paid much! *Is53:4-10; Phil2:5-8 the King paid our debt!
 - 4. How far would you go to express your love to Christ?
