The Life of David: The Battle is the LORD's; 1Samuel16,17

1. David and Goliath

A. The Fear of ______ and Israel (vs. 11, 23-24)

1. Israel's _____: 500 yrs; Eli judged, then God raised up Samuel, even w/ him, they continued to rebel against God (*1Sam8:5,7-8*)

2. Saul's _____: 1Sam13:13-14; 15:11, 13,14, 21-24 – Saul would not obey the LORD

*He feared man, would not follow the Lord, but came up with his own plans

3. KEY: The consequences of disobeying God and loving the world (*Deut.28:1-2,7,9-10 versus* 28:15,25; not even weapons for the nation – 1Sam13:19-22)

B. Goliath – armor – over _____lbs; spear head – _____lbs; over 9 and ½ ft tall!!! *Champion – a man ______the camps, was the man to fight on behalf of his nation; a professional killer; this was his life – killing people! goes into valley to blaspheme God, people

C. David – *1Sam17:33,42*; ruddy – red tone; age probably 15, Josephus says 10; he was young, small

- 1. Acts13:22; 1Sam16:18 he is known for being after God's heart, and the Lord was with him!
 - 2. Weapons: a staff and a sling those of a shepherd, wouldn't use Saul's armor

2. David Fights Goliath

- A. Why Would David Fight Goliath? 17:26,45
 - 1. David ______ the Lord, walked with Him and was appalled that anyone would blaspheme Him!
 - 2. Consider Jesus *John2:15-17*
- B. How Did David Know He Would Win?

He knew God would ______ for His own glory and to make His name known in all the earth!
*1Sam17:45-47 – this is THE reason he tells Goliath that he will defeat him
*David remembered his history – Moses and Egypt, always to be remembered in Israel
WHY did God harden Pharoah?

2. David walked with God and had a real, ______ relationship w/ Him! *ISam17:31-37*

*David had experienced God practically in his life – he **knew** the Lord as warrior! **THINK*: a young boy, teen, killing a lion w/ his bare hands!

**KEY*: as we experience God in our lives, those help us w/ what comes next!

C. God gives David victory! 1Sam17:48-51 - notice David's complete confidence!

4. The Battle is the LORD's (What does this have to do with us?)

A. Personal battles - Would God give us something greater than what we can handle?

1. consider David, Daniel? 3 Amigos? Moses delivering Israel from Egypt?

2. God is with us; we come to know Him personally in these times!

B. The Purpose of this Story – Acts13:22-39 (*vs.36) (also seen in Acts7)

*1. *God* was fulfilling His plan for Messiah from Gen3:15... Abraham, Joseph in Egypt, Moses w/ Israel in Egypt – Passover Lamb! Ruth and Boaz in time of judges...*Messiah!*

2. *Two* : God's and the World/Satan - What is the battle here in 1Samuel17 about? *It is about the glory of God and the will/plan of God for the ultimate salvation of man

3. *Jesus:* I will build My church and the gates of hell will not prevail against it. Jesus is on the offensive!!! *David is on the offensive, vs.48

4. Who will stand? Apostles and Paul and others through the ages; BUT what about NOW!

*The church today is like Israel in this story – afraid and loving the world

*Who will stand and fight for God's glory and will?!!! Matt.28:18; 2Cor10:3-6; Rev19:11-21
