Evidence of a Healthy Church: Excel in a Living Faith (5:12-28)

1. Church Relationships (vs.12-15)
A. Responsibility of the (pastors, elders)
1. diligently labor; Gk. to exhibit great effort, exertion to point of exhaustion; 2Tim2:6
2. have charge over; Gk.lit means to stand before, to preside, lead, direct – steers the ship
3. give you instruction; Gk. admonish, warn by correcting to live holy lives; 2Tim3:16-17 ; 4:1-3 *True spiritual Shepherds lead by God's Word; 2Tim2:15
*God's leaders must be able to teach God's Word, to feed and protect the sheep *Jesus to Peter, feed My sheep; also <i>Eph4:11-15</i>
B. Responsibility of the
1. appreciate them; Gk. to know closely by experience, entails heartfelt gratitude and respect *this is showing respect and high regard – 1Tim5:17
2. esteem them very highly in love; Gk. to regard, think about beyond all measure; lit. limitless respect; <i>WHY?</i> "because of their work" watching over your souls! <i>Heb13:17; 1Tim4:6,13,15-16</i>
3. follow their leadership and instruction – live at peace w/ your pastors and elders
C. Spiritual
1. admonish the unruly/wayward – come alongside and warn the insubordinate soldier
2. encourage the fainthearted – lit. small-souled; fearful, worried, only want things safe
3. help the weak – morally and spiritually weak/frail; support, hold these up
*be patient, don't repay evil for evil (is conflict); desire their good, their growth and maturity
2. Practical Christian Living – worship and serve the Lord (vs.16-22) *Rom12:1-2
A. In everything give thanks (vs.16-18) *worship God demands involves <i>constant</i> joy, prayer, thanks
1. rejoice – lit. "at all times be rejoicing" joy in all circumstances is key in true worship
*Ja1:2-4; 2Cor12:9-10; Rm8:28,31-32; this comes from deep grounded confidence in God
2. pray without – prayer as a way of life; pray at all times on all things <i>UNTIL</i> God answers! Watch and pray, be alert because of the devil; <i>1Jn5:14-15; Phil4:4-7</i>
3. in everything give – everything means <i>ALL</i> things, don't be ungrateful; because we
trust God, have His joy and are going to Him with everything, THANKING Him as we pray! *Col2:6-7; Ps136:1-3 – Notice: is the focus the circumstance or God Himself?!
B. Do not quench the Spirit (vs.19-22)
1. Do not the Spirit – Gk. to extinguish, stifle, the power of something; ex. smother fire
*Eph5:18 – be filled or controlled by the Spirit; disobedience, rebellion, sin breaks the Holy Spirit's control on our life, thus His power thru us for God's work
2. Do not prophetic utterances; Gk. publicly proclaim, preaching – don't despise preaching of God's Word – <i>2Tim4:3</i> ; but be good Bereans and go to God's Word
3. abstain from form of evil – hold fast, embrace wholeheartedly what is good; avoid wholeheartedly all that is evil – measure it by God's Word
