1. Act	ions of True Christians (vs.27-28) *Eph5:1-2; Lk6:27 – those who "hear"
	A. Love your – this was immoral and evil to Jews in Jesus' day
	1. Matt5:43-44 – Pharisees taught to hate those not like you, they were enemies
	2. Cultural Judaism, was a sin to save Gentile from drowning!
	3. Where did the Jews get this? From OT where God destroyed nations, prophets called fire
	4. But God said vengeance is MINE, not yours! Israel was God's sword, but Jesus came to save!
	*Deut.32:35; Rom12:17-21; Job31:29; Lev19:18; Who is my neighbor???
	5. Consider our racial and ethnic issues, other religions, sexually immoral, politics, small town
	B. Doto those who hate you – do what has lasting goodness for them
	1. What do I do that to those who hate me that will open a door for the gospel?
	2. This is loving them, not condoning their evil, hatred, etc. but seeking their salvation
	C. Bless those who you – we don't revile or attack, we bless
	1. We speak what will bless them – the whole gospel is the greatest blessing we can ever speak
	2. Love does <i>NOT</i> mean we by-pass justice; or condone sin, approve wrong things!
	3. Love means we confront sin that will send them to hell! Jesus did! *Luke6:20-26
	4. The gospel warns the wicked of the terrible Day of the Lord coming! This is love!
	D. Pray for those whoyou – consider Jesus on the cross, Stephen being stoned
	1. Paul – <i>Rom9:3; 10:1</i> – we pray for their salvation, for God to rescue them
	2. Sinners, vs.32 – the wicked, people outside of God's kingdom

	A. The supernatural love of Christ in His people the gospel
	1. They will see we are sons of the Most High God *John15:17-19; John13:34,35; Luke6:35
	2. When pressed, what comes out?

	*39 lashes on bare back; then would slap your face to dishonor, humiliate, did this to Jesus
	C. Takes away your also was done being thrown out of synagogue, this was key piece of clothing
	*had one outer cloak, would sleep in too; they took this from Jesus at cross and gambled for it
	D. Give to those in, or those who steal from you, don't demand it back
	*when someone takes advantage of your generosity, or steals your possessions = love them
	E. Treat others how you want to be treated(vs.31-38)
	1. vs.31, universally used don't do to others what you don't want them to do to you, selfish; Jesus
	- regardless, even if you harm me, I will love you anyway, like I would want you to love me.
	2. sinners do good, so good is done to them; "Karma" they say; they lend to one to
	lend to them – we love expecting nothing to be done in return for us, unconditional free love
	3. merciful – I withhold what you, as the Father (vs.36)
	4. judge – not withholding the law of justice; but being, hard, compassionless to
	enemies
	5. condemn – pronounce damnation on them; write them off and don't pray or try to reach them
	6. Give – love, mercy, forgiveness, kindness; they (sinners) will give back to
