1. Be Ready: Y	You Don't Know When Christ is Coming (vs.35-40)
A. It is	He is Coming (vs.40a)
	1. Jesus is coming! *Dan7:13-14; Mk2:10,28; Mk14:61-62
	2. This certainty is our motivation for how we live! *Luke9:23-26; Matt16:24-27
B. It is	when He is Coming (vs.40b)
	*The Point is <i>NOT</i> to figure out the day but to <i>Be Ready! *2Pe3:3-12</i>
	amples to be
	1. Be dressed in readiness (vs.35a) *pull in the loose ends of your life
	*Ex. Roman soldier in Eph6; Passover in Egypt
	2. Keep your lamps lit (vs.35b) *be alert, aware and prepared; Rom13:11-14
	*10 virgins – 5 wise and 5 unwise
	3. The Wedding (vs.36-38) *always be prepared at all times; wedding dates general time frame
	*wedding could last a week or more; slaves were to always be ready to open door, even
	in 3 <sup>rd</sup> watch – 12am-3am!
	4. The Thief (vs.39-40) *don't know the time, Christ will come when you don't expect it!
	*1Thes5:2-6; Rev3:3; Rev16:15
2. Be Ready: T	There is a Day of Reckoning When Christ Comes (vs.41-48)
A. How	do you handle what Christ has to you?
	1. The sensible slave – he is focused on the Master's (vs.41-44)
	*1Cor4:1-2; Rom8:16-18; 2Cor4:16-18 – focus is on what is eternal!
	*Great blessing from God for he is always about the work of the Master
	*He is ready when He returns
	2. The unsensible slave – he is (vs.45-46)
	*Severe condemnation from God *He is not ready when Christ returns
B. To w	whom much is given, is required (vs.47-48)
	1. We will give an account to God based on what we have and what we know (wealth/Bibles)
	*Matt25:19-21, 24-28 – Reward vs. Judgment based on how we live *Eccl12:6, 13-14
	2. 3 levels of judgment: hacking many lashes few lashes
	3. The Story of the 3 demons
C. How	do we get ourselves ready to see Jesus?
	1. Abandon hypocrisy and greed: <i>fear God</i> not man (vs.5); <i>trust God</i> , be a and live
	your life with all He gives you for His kingdom! Store treasures in heaven! (vs.30-34)
	2. Live for Christ's kingdom (vs.19-21)
