Evidence of a Healthy Church: Continual Spiritual Growth (1Thess.4:1-2)

Introduction: – to excel still more; to abound, overflow, be abundantly supplied, be extraordinary – this speaks of your!
Notice: 4:3 and 3:10; 4:7,10; Phil1:9; 2Pe3:18
1.Why don't all athletes do this?
2. What about knowing and loving Christ? *what distinguishes mediocrity from powerful life?
3. Just like w/ an athlete, you have to do certain things that everyone else does that are okay to do
4. The vast majority of people saying they are Christians are fine to be mediocre w/ Christ;
5. <i>Heb12:14</i> – this is important!
*4 Keys that will cause you to EXCEL in your Christ-life
1. Excel More: Never Be with Mediocrity and Complacency (vs.1a)
A. Request and exhort: Gk. to encourage lovingly
B. A casual, comfortable, complacent Christian life is <i>not</i> from God but the world!
1. Was there any constant complacency about Jesus' life? Paul's? Heroes of faith?
2. Rom12:11; Prov12:27; 24:30-34
C. Spiritual growth is goal, comes from a longing to know God (Ps42:1-2; 63:1-3; Matt5:6; Phil3:10)
2. Excel More: You Must Have Power (vs.1a)
*"In the Lord Jesus" – you must be born-again, be in Christ and Christ in you! (Rom8:37; Eph1:18-21)
3. Excel More: You Must Have Motivation (vs.1a) (*Here is biggest key!!!)
A. Why do so many Christians rarely go to church, read and obey their Bibles, share gospel, etc.?
*they lack the right! *What is the issue? Obedience problem?!
B. Love for Christ is the right motivation for continuing to excel! *see 4:1
*"In the Lord Jesus" *Jn14:21; 2Cor5:14-15 – love has grown cold, or never truly loved Christ
C. Duty or deep love?
1. Why? Because he taught from God's Word that people must be born-again to take communior
2. <u>Central Ohio</u> : church people refuse to obey God's clear word on conflict! Gossip = God
*Why? 1John2-5 all speak to evidence of love for God = love for
*Romans6:16-18,22 – why do so many refuse to obey God's clear Word?
3. A true intimate love relationship? *Rom8:29-30 – foreknew is foreloved, love relationship *Matt7:21-23 – what's the issue here?
4. Excel More: You Must Have Plan (vs.1b-2)
A. God's Word is God's plan for your sanctification (this is all of chp4,5!)
1. What would happen if you got to eat food and drink water, as often as you read your Bible?
2. James1:22 – what's the key?

B. Growing takes a conscious effort ("instruction as how to walk"; "authority of Lord Jesus")
1. <i>Romans13:11-14</i> – what does Paul tell us?!
*Actually aside the deeds of darkness, behave, and on the deeds of Christ
*Eph5:14-17 – awake, be careful, be exact in how you live your time left on earth!
2. Will you begin to adjust your life and work God's program? <i>Look at vs.3-4!</i>
