	iacs, The Demons and The Dimwits (vs.26-33)
A. The	Demoniacs – 2 men (Matt8), but all accounts focus on; possessed by over 2000 demons
	1. No clothing: OT uncovering one's nakedness sign of sexual immorality, shame; Rev3:18
	2. suicidal (Mk5:5); screaming constantly day/night; pain, insanity, totally unhinged; notice,
	gashing himself (cutting is demonic) from pagan religions
	3. lived in tombs – dwelled in the place of death, more at home there than w/ living, homes
	*Matt8:28 – run out of tombs, screaming and beat, kill those who came by
	*Could not be bound w/ chains and shackles, completely naked – why do people glorify death?
B. The	Demons – fallen, vast knowledge of God/Jesus, existed from creation
	1. Demoniac comes running at Jesus, but when demons see Jesus, completely terrified!
	*They know who Jesus is, in great panick – <i>Mk5:6,7; Lk8:28</i>
	*Jesus is their executioner and judge $-Lk8:31$ – abyss, bottomless pit; place demons are
	held, many from Gen6 (2Pe2:4; Jude6,7; <i>Rev9:1-11</i> )
	* <i>Matt8:29</i> – He is the One who will cast them into the lake of fire!
	2. Legion ( <i>Lk8:30</i> ) – up to 6000 Roman soldiers; <i>Mk5:12,13</i> – at least 2000 demons; 1 spoke
	*They ask permission to go into the herd of 2000 pigs, then killed them all!
C. The	Dimwits – all the people in the city, and surrounding district
	1. The herdsmen – immediately run away to tell city and in country; why? 2000 pigs is a lot of
	AND, just saw the!
	2. The city, country, district – they see the dead pigs, the demoniac now dressed in his right mind
	and are completely! (see vs.35, 37)
2. Responding	to the Real Jesus (vs.34-39)
	Dimwits – consider what they, and <i>like so many today</i> , asked Jesus to leave!
110 1110	1. The man, years was hurting, murdering, totally unhinged, now saved, totally changed! vs36
	2. They saw 2000 dead pigs and heard the story of how Jesus cast out demons into pigs
	3. They saw the real Jesus, in His power, and they were exposed! *Like Peter in the boat
	4. These people were more comfortable w/ demons and a maniac killer than with Jesus!!!
	Unlikely Missionary – this man is completely and saved! (vs.35,36; *38,39)
	1. He has only one care now, being with Jesus! Nothing else matters! ***Matt13:44!
	2. Jesus sends him to those who rejected Him; he goes to the Decapolis (10 cities, Gentile
	strongholds after Pompey invaded Palestine) – he becomes a preacher/missionary!

	1. Notice: the evidence and power did NOT the Gentiles, nor Pharisees, Jews!
	2. What are you more comfortable with? Focused on? Are you distracted w/ the world?
	*Consider how this man lived, the prostitute woman, changed after Jesus saved and transformed
	them*Mark8:34-36; 2Cor5:14,15
