Evidence of a Healthy Church: Sanctification in the Midst of Grief; part2

1. Review: Comfort in the Midst of Grief (vs.13)
A. Paul's in this passage is pastoral, to comfort those grieving over pain and loss. vs13,18
B. Paul answers the question: what happens to Christians when they die?
1. They are "asleep"; Gk. where we get the word, cemetery; sleeping place, dormitory
2. Unique for Christians'; bodies are unconscious, but our spirit is eternally conscious!
*John11:11; 1Cor15:6,18,51; 2Cor5:8; Ex.Acts7:59-60, and thief on the cross – Today, you will
3. Our bodies will be awakened, NEW, by Christ, united w/ our spirit! <i>Jn5:25; 1Cor15:51-53</i>
C. So, we do not "grieve" like the lost world, who has no – NO finality for a true believer!
*Christians NEVER truly say good-bye, as NOT to see our loved ones again; we will be reunited
at the great gathering of the Church, the Bride of Christ, and we will know/recognize each other
*1Thess4:17; 1Thess2:19-20; 2Thess2:1; 2Cor4:14
2. Foundations of the Rapture: great gathering up of Church, NOT O.T. saints to Christ in the air! Vs.14-17
A. Remember: is word for "caught up"; snatched up w/ extreme force
1. Always used in times of distress to comfort, NEVER even a hint of judgment ever used
2. Day of the Lord, always only judgment, is AFTER Rapture, see order, 1Thess4,5; 2Thes2:1-3
3. God doesn't pour out wrath and judgment on His Son's Bride! <i>1Thess1:10; Rom8:1</i> ; Eph5
B of Rapture: (vs.14-15a) *death of Christ; *resurrection of Christ; *revelation of Christ
C. Who's in the rapture? 1."we who are alive" (15b) and those 2."who have fallen asleep in Jesus" (14b)
D. Specific Plan, Features of the Rapture: (vs.16-17) these are different than Olivet Discourse Matt24 1. Lord from heaven – He Himself snatches us up to Himself, takes to heaven and fulfills John14:1-3; He comes FOR us in air, 2 nd coming He comes WITH us to earth
2. With a: Gk, military command, Attention! Stand! *Jn11:43; Jn5:25
3. Voice of archangel; no "the" in Gk.; no definite archangel; Jude9 speaks of Michael and in <i>Dan12:1-3</i> *(Jn5:28-29) of nation of Israel, this is when O.T. saints are raised, like Job, (Rev20:4-6), after Tribulation! We know this because Dan11:36-45 speaks of anti-christ
4. Trumpet of – trumpets w/ Israel were used many reasons, to assemble to meet God and for deliverance – we are assembled to meet Christ in the air and delivered from this world!
5. Dead <i>in</i> Christ will rise <i>NOTICE</i> "in Christ", this is the Church; asleep now awakened!
6 who are alive are "caught up" w/ them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air *snatched w/ extreme force; same word in John10; and Philip snatched by Holy Spirit *clouds of glory as the clouds Jesus ascended in, in Acts1; we are transformed! Phil3:21 *we meet the Lord in the air, again, not 2 nd Coming, that is on earth

^{*}The Lord snatches us up out of this fallen world; the world will rejoice we are gone, as Satan and Anti-Christ deceive; we are in heaven at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, and being rewarded for our life on earth(1Cor3:13-15; 2Cor5:10); during those 7 years, God is unleashing His wrath upon the earth, the Great Tribulation, Rev6-18; then Jesus comes with us and ends that Tribulation by killing all the enemies of God! *Notice: Rev19:7-10, and then Rev19:11-16
