Pure Joy: Pursuing the Prize (Philippians3:12-16)

1. Honest Evaluation: vs.12a

- with true condition: (30yrs after conversion) A. ____
 - 1. "Not" listen everyone, make no mistake
 - 2. I have *not* reached perfection and/or obtained the prize I'm not there yet!
- B. ______ ignites hunger for more, progress: Therefore I still have a lot of work to do! 1. *Phil3:10,11* I know Him...His power...His fellowship... but not fully

 - 2. I cannot coast or take it easy, I have to put my foot on the gas pedal! BECAUSE I know Him!
- 2. Tenacious Initiative: vs.12b (this is a deep hunger that overrides everything else!)
 - A. "I press on" usually translated in NT, to be persecuted, which means to be chased, run out of town
 - 1. Press on, is an aggressive, bearing down on, *Ex.* like a lion bearing down on antelope!
 - 2. Paul is chasing after a prize (vs. 7-8) *the Lord Jesus Christ with all his might!
 - 3. Example: runner pursuing the finish line, w/ all his energy he presses forward!
 - B. What is he pressing on to do?
 - 1. to lay hold of that for which he was laid hold of by Christ...
 - 2. "lay hold" is a strong verb, to seize with aggressive effort
 - 3. "that for which I was laid hold of" full knowledge of Christ and His purpose (Acts26:16-20)

3. Singular Resolve: vs.13,14

- : my life has resolve for only ONE THING! A. ONE
 - 1. One ambition narrow focus, like looking through a keyhole on ONE ambition, the Prize!
 - 2. The one thing of vs. 13 is vs.14 to win the prize
- B. ONE to have singular resolve...
 - 1. The hindrance/weight...Forget what is behind... *3 things hinder and weigh us down...
 - 1. past sins (1Tim1:13-15; Ps103:11,12; Rom8:1; Mic7:18-19) BELIEVE GOD!!!
 - 2. past hurts think of Paul... consider Joseph; Gen41:51! Mannasseh! bitterness and un-forgiveness are a weight!!!
 - 3. past successes 2Cor12:7 pride brings prayerlessness and self-reliance
 - 2. The resolve...Reach forward; 2 prefixes in Gk. word, means (stretch...stretch)
- C. ONE : I will press on and grab hold of the only thing that matters to me – Jesus Christ!
 - 1. The longer Paul runs, the harder he bears down/presses on and the faster he runs!!!
 - 2. Paul is running his best race towards the end of his life! *Why?*

3. All things in him and in his life are all moving w/ one resolve for one goal – Christ!

Conclusion: vs.15,16; *Romans13:10-14*
