A Brief Review

There is one God eternally existing in three persons as a perfect Unity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit (3 in 1). The Holy Spirit, as the third member of the Trinity, is (1) a person – not a force or power or influence and (2) He is God – equal in glory and power and divinity with both the Father and the Son. And although the Trinity is one in essence and nature; the persons of the Trinity have different roles or functions they perform in both Creation and the Redemption of man. A summary of the working of the Holy Spirit can be seen in these four words, the Holy Spirit: Empowers, Purifies, Reveals, and Unifies. The HS was present and active in the OT and in the Life of Christ.
