... being continually aware that your labor [even to the point of exhaustion] in the Lord is not futile nor wasted [it is never without purpose].



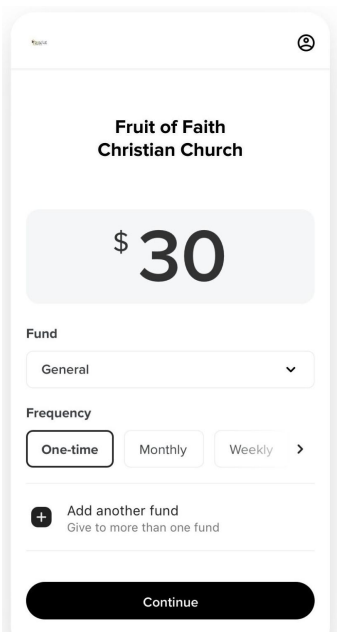

Genesis 41:43 (NLT)

43 Then he had Joseph ride in the chariot reserved for his second-in-command....

Genesis 41:45 (NLT)

45 Then Pharaoh gave Joseph a new Egyptian name, Zaphenath-paneah. He also gave him a wife, whose name was Asenath. She was the daughter of Potiphera, the priest of On. So Joseph took charge of the entire land of Egypt.



Genesis 41:46 (NLT)

46 He was thirty years old when he began serving in the court of Pharaoh, the king of Egypt. And when Joseph left Pharaoh's presence, he inspected the entire land of Egypt.



Genesis 41:53-54 (NLT)

53 At last the seven years of bumper crops throughout the land of Egypt came to an end. 54

Then the seven years of famine began, just as Joseph had predicted. The famine also struck all the surrounding countries, but throughout Egypt there was plenty of food.



Genesis 41:55 (NLT)

55 Eventually, however, the famine spread throughout the land of Egypt as well. And when the people cried out to Pharaoh for food, he told them, “Go to Joseph, and do whatever he tells you.”

Amos 8:11-12 (NLT)

11 “The time is surely coming,” says the Sovereign Lord, “when I will send a famine on the land—not a famine of bread or water but of hearing the words of the Lord. 12 People will stagger from sea to sea and wander from border to border searching for the word of the Lord, but they will not find it.
