ROMANS 1:16



Romans 1:16 (NIV)

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.



Romans 1:17 (NIV)

17 For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”



1 Corinthians 2:14 (NIV)

Repent

Repentance is a call to a radical change of mind and heart, turning away from sin and towards God. It involves acknowledging one's sins, seeking forgiveness, and committing to a new way of life. Repentance is a prerequisite for entering the kingdom of heaven.
