# I, Idols, & Enemies

Judges 6-7 (NLT)

# Judges 6:1 (NLT)

*6 The Israelites did evil in the Lord's sight.*

*There is a way that appears to be right, but in the end it leads to death. Proverbs 14:12*

# Judges 6:1 (NLT)

*...So the Lord handed them over to the Midianites for seven years.*

*“You have always put a wall of protection around him and his home and his property. You have made him prosper in everything he does.” Job 1:10 (NLT)*

# Judges 6:6-8 (NLT)

*6 So Israel was reduced to starvation by the Midianites. Then the Israelites cried out to the Lord for help. 7 When they cried out to the Lord because of Midian, 8 the Lord sent a prophet to the Israelites.*

**You need a cry and NOT a complaint!**

# Judges 6:10 (NLT)

*10 I told you, 'I am the Lord your God. You must not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you now live.' But you have not listened to me."*

**No conquest without,**

**when there is compromise within!**

# Judges 6:24 (NLT)

*24 And Gideon built an altar to the Lord there and named it Yahweh-Shalom (which means “the Lord is peace”). The altar remains in Ophrah in the land of the clan of Abiezer to this day.*

*“I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.”” John 16:33 (ESV)*

# Judges 6:25-26 (NLT)

*25 That night the Lord said to Gideon, “...Pull down your father’s altar to Baal, and cut down the Asherah pole standing beside it.” 26 Then build an altar to the Lord your God here on this hilltop sanctuary, ...”*

# Exodus 20:3 (ESV)

*“You shall have no other gods before me.”*

# Judges 6:27 (NLT)

*27 So Gideon took ten of his servants and did as the Lord had commanded. But he did it at night because he was afraid of the other members of his father's household and the people of the town.*

# Joshua 1:9 (NLT)

*This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”*



# Judges 6:33 (NLT)

*33 Soon afterward the armies of Midian, Amalek, and the people of the east formed an alliance against Israel and crossed the Jordan, camping in the valley of Jezreel.*

# Judges 6:34-35 (NLT)

*34 Then the Spirit of the Lord clothed Gideon with power. He blew a ram's horn as a call to arms, and the men of the clan of Abiezer came to him. 35 He also sent messengers throughout Manasseh, Asher, Zebulun, and Naphtali, summoning their warriors, and all of them responded.*

# Judges 7:2 (NLT)

*2 The Lord said to Gideon, “You have too many warriors with you. If I let all of you fight the Midianites, the Israelites will boast to me that they saved themselves by their own strength.*

# Judges 7:7 (NLT)

*7 The Lord told Gideon, “With these 300 men I will rescue you and give you victory over the Midianites. Send all the others home.”*

# Judges 7:9 (NLT)

*9 That night the Lord said, “Get up! Go down into the Midianite camp, for I have given you victory over them!”*

# Judges 7:14 (NLT)

*14 His companion answered, “Your dream can mean only one thing—God has given Gideon son of Joash, the Israelite, victory over Midian and all its allies!”*

# Judges 7:15 (NLT)

*15 When Gideon heard the dream and its interpretation, he bowed in worship before the Lord. Then he returned to the Israelite camp and shouted, “Get up! For the Lord has given you victory over the Midianite hordes!”*
