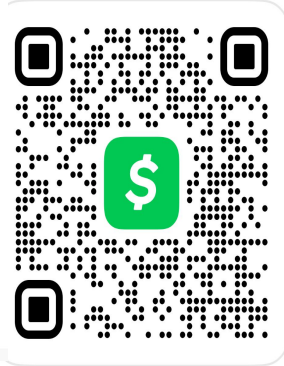

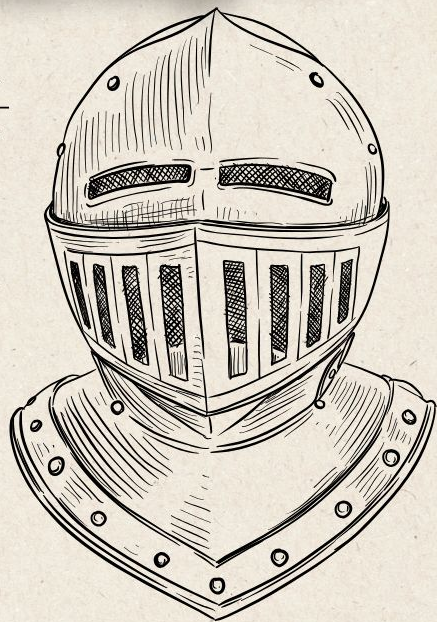

# The Full Armor of GOD

Ephesians 6:10-17

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11  
Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand  
against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against  
flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities,  
against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual  
forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

## **The Whole Armor of God**

**The Battlefield Is the Mind. A helmet protects the head — the control center. Spiritual warfare often begins in our thoughts. The enemy attacks with: Doubt, Fear, Condemnation, Identity confusion**

**Ephesians 6:17a NLT**





*Since the Battlefield is the Mind...Remember*



*2 And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His plan and purpose for you].*

Those things God gives to fight with destroy the strong-places of the devil.* 5 **We break down every thought and proud thing that puts itself up against the wisdom of God. We take hold of every thought and make it obey Christ.**

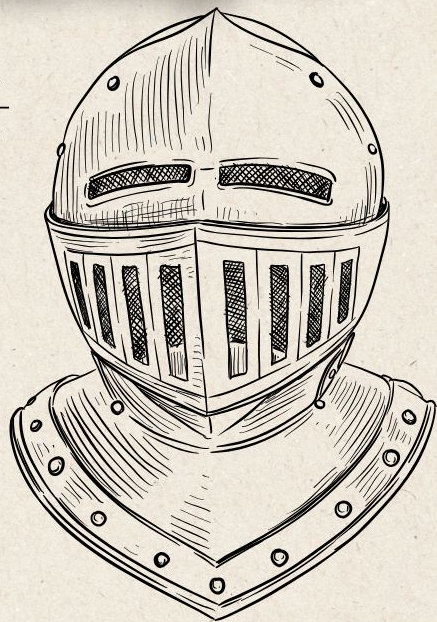


# “Supporting Scriptures about Salvation”

- **1<sup>st</sup> Thessalonians 5:8 NIV:** But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.
- Paul directly connects the helmet with hope in salvation. The helmet protects the head—symbolically the mind—so this verse emphasizes confident assurance in salvation as protection against doubt and spiritual attack.
- **Isaiah 59:17a NIV:** He put on righteousness as his breastplate, and the helmet of salvation on his head;
- This is the Old Testament foundation for Paul's imagery. God Himself is described as wearing salvation like a helmet, showing salvation as divine protection and victory.
- **Isaiah 26:3 NKJV:** You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.
- The helmet protects the mind. This verse supports the idea that salvation stabilizes our thoughts and brings peace through trust in God.

# “The Helmet of Salvation”

- **Foundation Based:** The Helmet of Salvation represents the protection of our mind through the assurance & hope of our salvation. Just as a helmet protects a soldier’s head in battle, salvation protects our thoughts in spiritual warfare.
  - **Active Application:** Wearing The Helmet of Salvation daily requires that: You remind yourself who you are in Christ. Declare God’s promises over your mind. Reject thoughts that contradict salvation. Anchor your confidence in what Jesus has done and not in your own performance.
  - **Summary:** The Helmet of Salvation protects your identity, confidence, and peace. When your mind is protected, your life is strengthened!
