Genesis 40:1-4 (NLT)

40 Some time later, Pharaoh's chief cup-bearer and chief baker offended their royal master. 2 Pharaoh became angry with these two officials, 3 and he put them in the prison where Joseph was, in the palace of the captain of the guard.

Genesis 40:4 (NLT)

4 They remained in prison for quite some time, and the captain of the guard assigned them to Joseph, who looked after them.

Genesis 40:5-7 (NLT)

5 While they were in prison, Pharaoh's cup-bearer and baker each had a dream one night, and each dream had its own meaning. 6 When Joseph saw them the next morning, he noticed that they both looked upset. 7 "Why do you look so worried today?" he asked them.

Genesis 40:8 (NLT)

8 And they replied, “We both had dreams last night, but no one can tell us what they mean.”

“Interpreting dreams is God’s business,” Joseph replied. “Go ahead and tell me your dreams.”



Genesis 40:20 (NLT)

20 Pharaoh's birthday came three days later, ... 21 He then restored the chief cup-bearer ... 22 But Pharaoh impaled the chief baker, just as Joseph had predicted when he interpreted his dream. 23 Pharaoh's chief cup-bearer, however, forgot all about Joseph, never giving him another thought.

Genesis 41:1,8 (NLT)

Two full years later, Pharaoh dreamed...

8 The next morning Pharaoh was very disturbed by the dreams. So he called for all the magicians and wise men of Egypt. When Pharaoh told them his dreams, not one of them could tell him what they meant.

Genesis 41:9-10 (NLT)

9 Finally, the king's chief cup-bearer spoke up.

“Today I have been reminded of my failure,” he told Pharaoh. 10 “Some time ago, you were angry with the chief baker and me, and you imprisoned us in the palace of the captain of the guard.

Genesis 41:11-13 (NLT)

11 One night the chief baker and I each had a dream, and each dream had its own meaning. 12 There was a young Hebrew man with us in the prison who was a slave of the captain of the guard. We told him our dreams, and he told us what each of our dreams meant. 13 And everything happened just as he had predicted.

Genesis 41:14 (NLT)

14 Pharaoh sent for Joseph at once, and he was quickly brought from the prison. After he shaved and changed his clothes, he went in and stood before Pharaoh.

Genesis 41:15 (NLT)

15 Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, “I had a dream last night, and no one here can tell me what it means. But I have heard that when you hear about a dream you can interpret it.”

Genesis 41:16 (NLT)

16 “It is beyond my power to do this,” Joseph replied. “But God can tell you what it means and set you at ease.”
