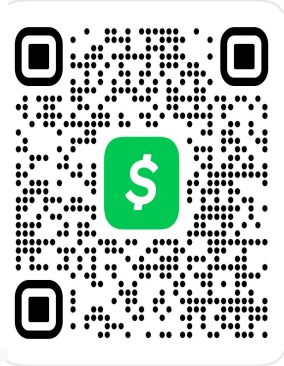

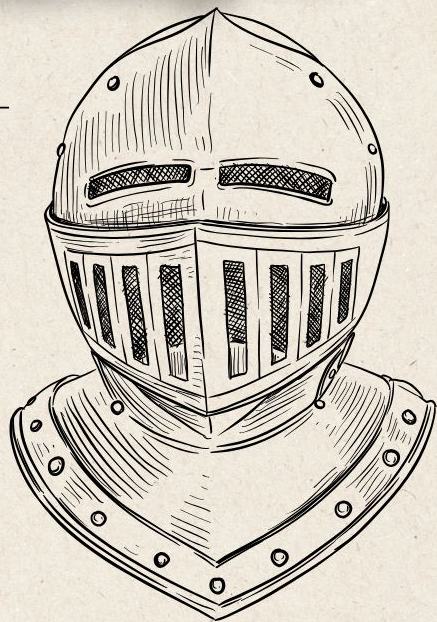

The Whole Armor of God

shod/fitted – G5265 (hypodeō) Greek

* to bind on – to bind under one's feet

shod/fitted – G1210 (deō) Greek

* to bind/fasten with chains



The Whole Armor of God

preparation/readiness – G2091 (hetoimasia) Greek

* a condition of readiness or being prepared

- > preliminary
- > arrange
- > equip



The Whole Armor of God

gospel – G2098 (euangelion) Greek

* the proclamation of the grace of God manifest and pledged in Christ



The Whole Armor of God

of peace – G1515 (eirēnē) Greek

*** security, safety, prosperity, felicity, (because peace and harmony make and keep things safe and prosperous)**

*** exemption from the rage and havoc of war**

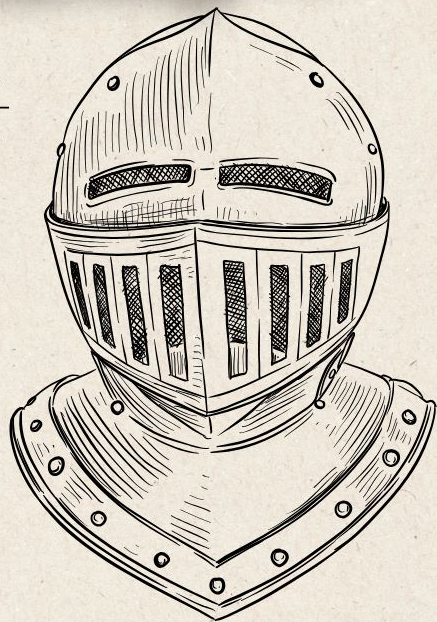


“The Shoes of Peace”

- **Foundation Based:** Any attacking soldier not wearing shoes substantial enough for the attack would soon find himself crippled or killed. Though the shoes were not by any means the most well-known part of the soldier's armor, they were vital. The same is true where the armor of God is concerned.
 - **Active Application:** God's soldiers have two purposes: defensive and offensive. In order to defend ourselves against the “flaming arrows of the evil one” we must have confidence of our position in Christ. We must stand firm in the truth of God's Word, regardless of how terrifying the circumstances may be
 - In addition to standing our ground, shoes are also for moving. God expects us to go on the offensive and take the gospel of peace to others.
 - **Summary:** You are secure with God, steady inside, and prepared to walk into difficult situations as a peacemaker — not a chaos carrier. Peace becomes your posture, not just your mood. And the beautiful part? This kind of peace doesn't make you passive. It makes you unshakable and effective.

Supporting Scriptures

- **Deuteronomy 33:25 NKJV: Your sandals shall be iron and bronze; As your days, so shall your strength be.**
- Together, the verse is saying: You may walk hard roads, but you'll be built for them. And you won't face a single day underpowered. It's about endurance, divine support, and not being abandoned to weakness. A lot of people lean on this verse in seasons of stress or responsibility because it reassures them that capacity comes with the calling.
- **Habakkuk 3:19 KJV:The Lord God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.**
- A hind is a female deer — especially known in the Bible lands for: Balance, Sure footing, Agility, Ability to climb steep, rocky terrain without slipping. So this means: God gives me stability and the ability to move safely through dangerous or difficult situations. It's not about removing the mountain — it's about being able to navigate it without falling.
- **Philippians 4:6-7 AMP: Do not be anxious or worried about anything, but in everything [every circumstance and situation] by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, continue to make your [specific] requests known to God. 7 And the peace of God [that peace which reassures the heart, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] stands guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [is yours].**
- Don't carry what's crushing you — hand it to God in prayer, thank Him in advance, and His peace will protect your mind even before the situation changes.
