(The 91st division of Psalms can guide your prayer for you pastor)

15 "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. 16 But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.' 17 And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the church. But if he refuses to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector.

Keys to Success: #7 Avoid sins of the

tongue

Ephesians 4:29-32 NKJV

29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. 32 And be kind to one another, even as God in Christ forgave you

Keys to Success: When someone tries to

contaminate you with gossip or gripes as these 5 questions:

- 1. What's your reason for telling me this?
 - 2. Where did you get your information?
 - 3. Have you gone directly to the person?
 - 4. Have you checked out your facts?
- 5. May I quote you when I check this out? (Biblical Reference - Proverbs 12:5-7)

#17 Walk in love & wisdom toward all people

#24 Don't submit books or audio messages for review and ask for his opinion

#25 Introduce him properly

#26 Don't expect your Pastor to be at every ministry or meeting



#27 Never receive an accusation against your Pastor that is not substantiated by 2 or 3 credible witnesses (1Tim. 5:19NLT)

#28 BE DISCERNING!!! (1Corn. 12:8-10 NLT)



#29 Be thoughtful & considerate for your pastor & his family

#30 Stay teachable and pliable
