


The church is the called out.





Worship is a verb it is not a noun it means to do something.

- 4 For the Lord is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.
- 5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the Lord made the heavens.
- 6 Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.
- 7 **Give** unto the Lord, O ye kindreds of the people, **give** unto the Lord glory and strength.

Worship involves giving


We ascribe what we know who the Lord God is. We attribute thus ascribing him the glory due Him.

We give him our mind, strength, beauty, power and glory.


We must voluntarily give God back to him what he has given us.

But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth:


for the Father seeketh such to worship him.




