

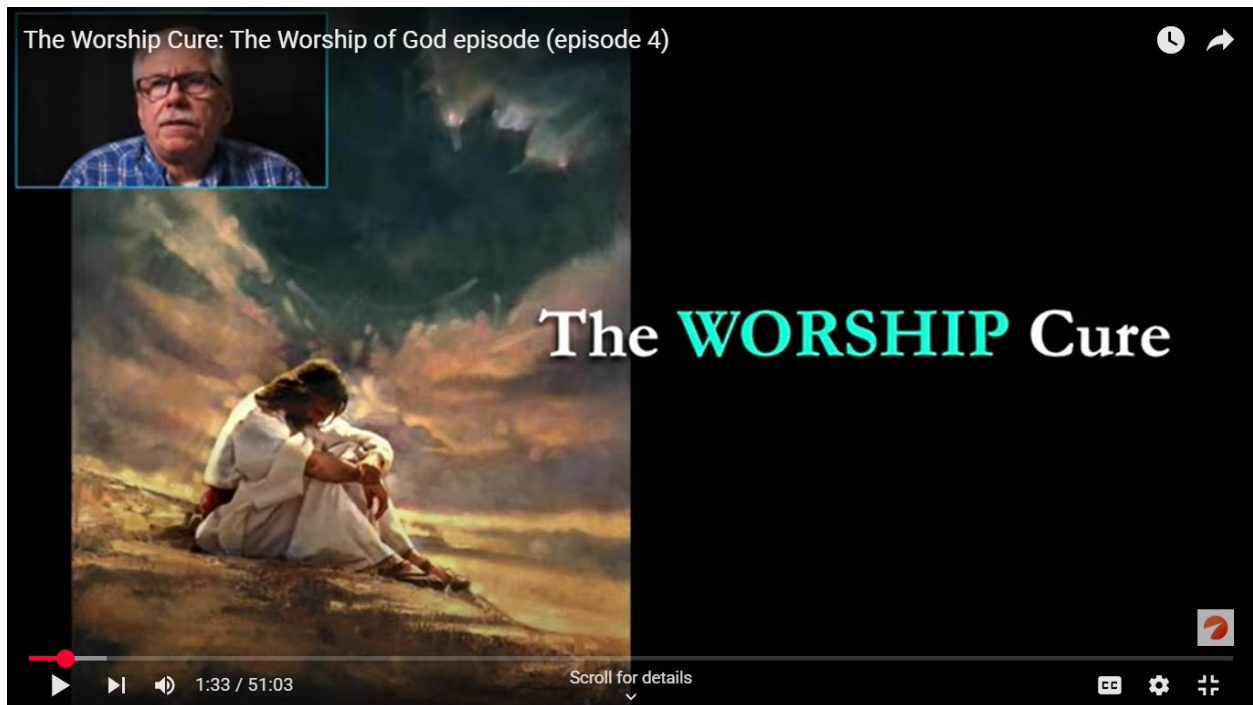

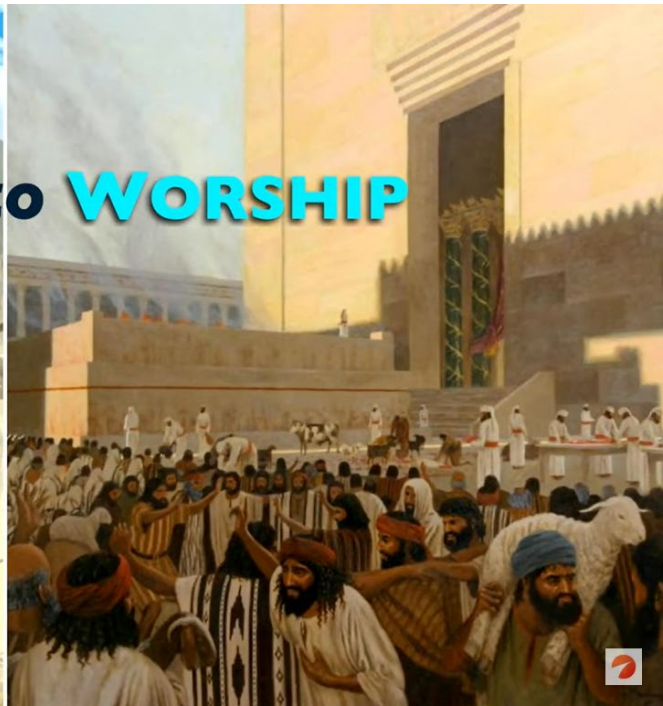

Deuteronomy 6:21,22

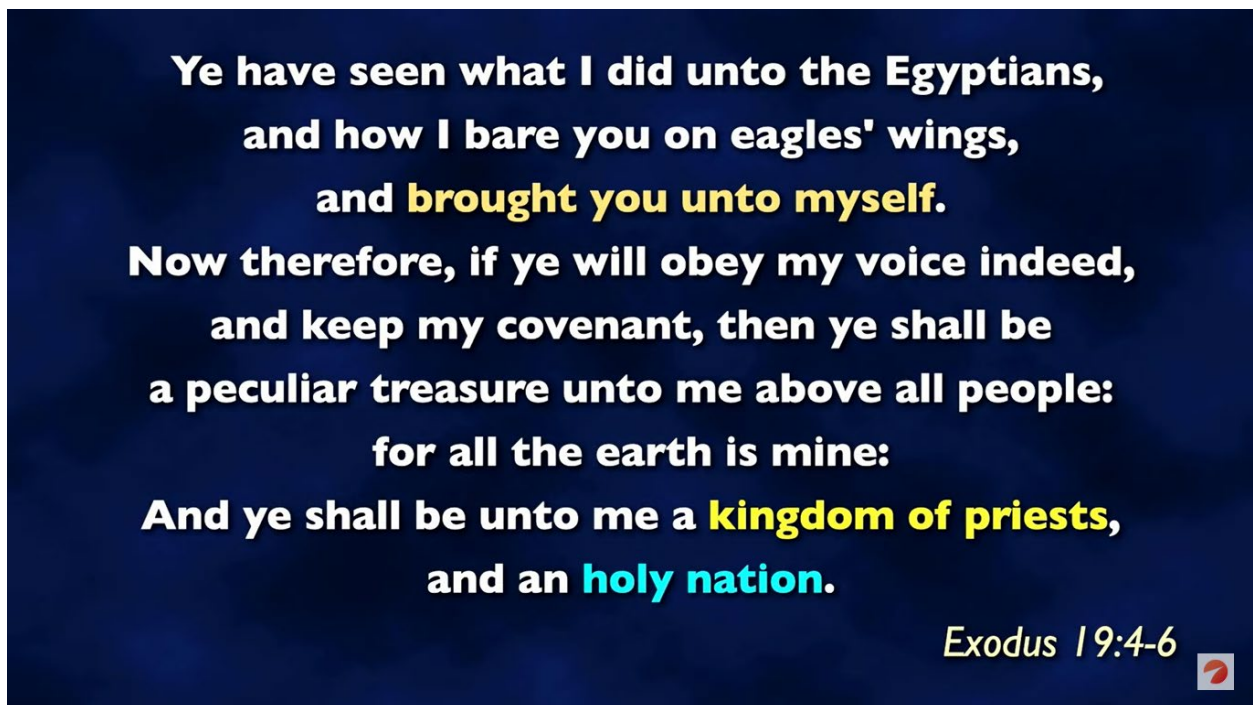
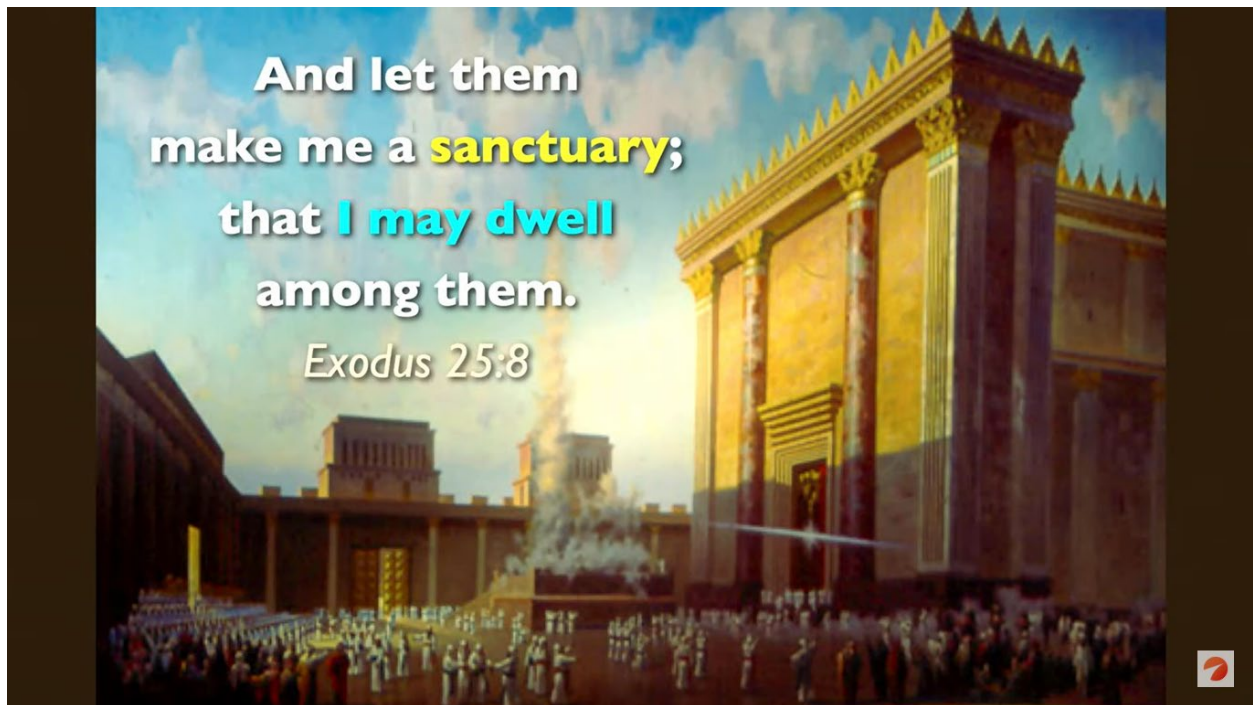


**And he brought us out from thence,

Sing unto the LORD a new song,

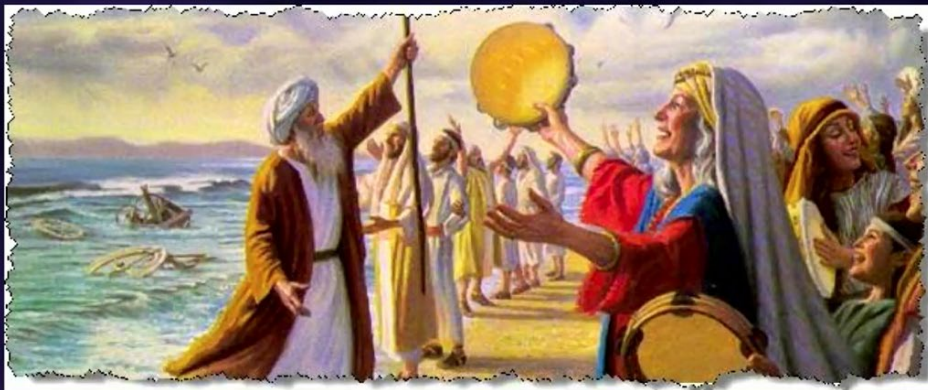
and his praise in the congregation of saints.

Worship is a verb it is not a noun it means to do something.

Ps 96:1-9 O sing unto the Lord a new song: sing unto the Lord, all the earth.

2 Sing unto the Lord, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day.

3 Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.

4 For the Lord is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.

5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the Lord made the heavens.

6 Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.

7 **Give** unto the Lord, O ye kindreds of the people, **give** unto the Lord glory and strength.

8 **Give** unto the Lord the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.

9 O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.

Worship involves giving

We ascribe what we know who the Lord God is. We attribute thus ascribing him the glory due Him.

ascribe ye greatness unto our God.

**for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth
and without iniquity, just and right is he.**

John 4:23,24

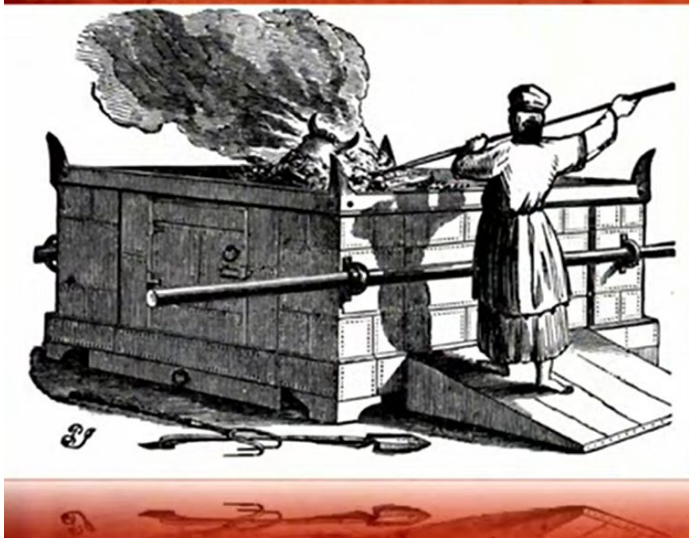


**...Well hath Esaias prophesied of you

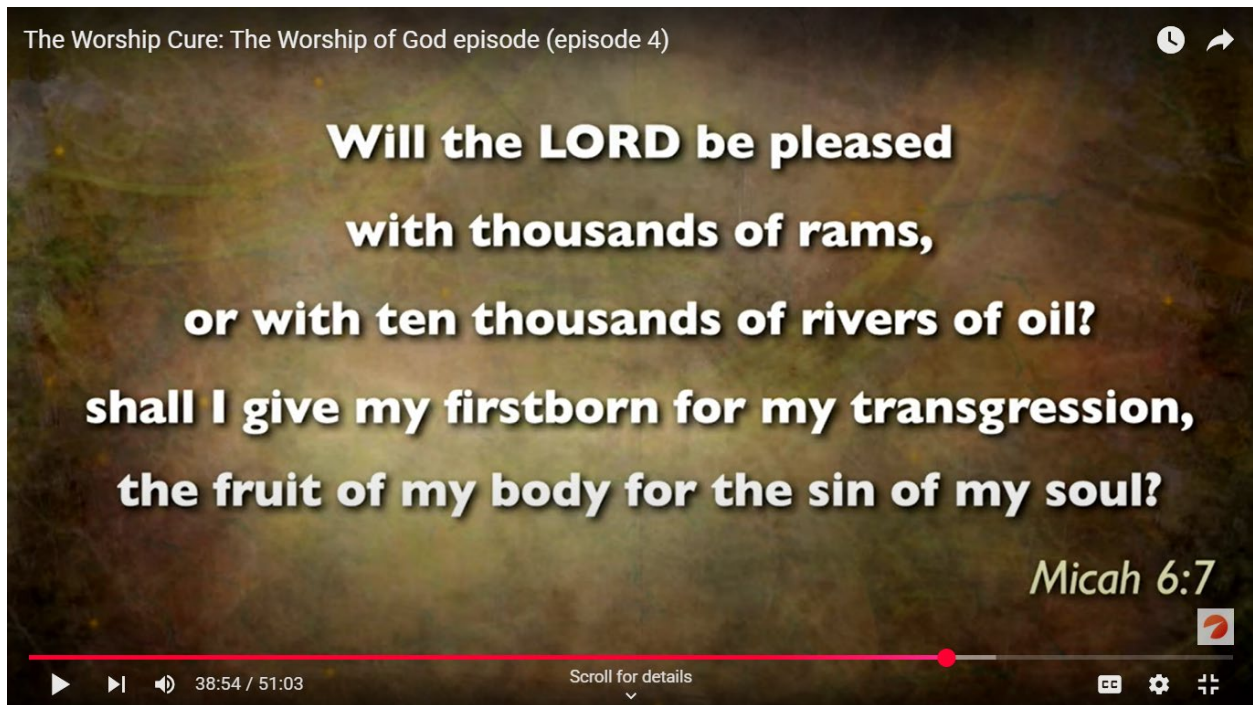
