Key attributes of God's anger include:

- Righteous and holy. Unlike human anger, which is often selfish, petty, and impulsive, God's anger is always pure and justified. It is a necessary reaction to moral evil and an expression of his perfect nature, which cannot tolerate sin or injustice.
- A product of his love. God's anger arises from his love and care for his creation, not from personal offense. As a loving and just God, he must confront evil to protect what he loves. The biblical narrative presents God's wrath not as incompatible with his love but as a necessary means to resolve the problem of evil and bring about redemption.
- Slow. The Bible repeatedly describes God as being "slow to anger" (Exodus 34:6; Psalm 103:8). This attribute highlights his patience and longsuffering, giving people time to repent before judgment is carried out.
- Controlled and not arbitrary. God does not "fly off the handle" or lose control. His anger is deliberate and measured, a sober response to human rebellion and disobedience. The punishment he administers is always proportionate to the offense.
- Often temporary for his people. For believers who are corrected and repent, God's anger is temporary, while his favor is everlasting

(Psalm 30:5). However, the Bible also speaks of eternal wrath for those who remain unrepentant (Romans 2:5).

- Restorative and redemptive. God's anger is not meant for destruction but often serves a redemptive purpose, aiming to bring about repentance and restore a right relationship with his people (Hosea 14:4).
- Satisfied by Jesus. The New Testament teaches that God's righteous anger toward sin was fully satisfied by the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ on the cross. For those who believe, God's wrath is appeased, and they are reconciled to him.

### **The Comfort of the Lord**

#### **Is 40:1,3-5, Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God.**

<sup>3</sup> The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

<sup>4</sup> Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain:

<sup>5</sup> And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.

(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
