You Must Meet Them Where They Are

(not where you want them to be)

Don't assume people know about Jesus.

Take time to see what they know by building relationship and asking questions.

Whatever you do, don't judge them and come to conclusions in your mind.

Be gracious enough to assume they know nothing, but be humble enough to assume they know more than you do.

You Must Be Committed to the Long Game

The Bible refers to souls as "seeds" that we plant and God waters.

And it takes time for a plant to grow.

Be as delicate, gracious, and consistent with people as you would be with a growing plant.

You Must Show Grace and Be Consistent

Take into consideration that you have to win someone over. The enemy sometimes has been speaking to their mind for years.

Don't add fuel to the fire with discouraging words.

Even though they may make excuses for a while, be consistent in love and grace.

Every Soul Is Unique

Every person is a person and is fearfully made by God.

Winning souls is not systematic. You have to take time and show genuine love to every individual.

Some will be harder than others, and some will be easier.

SEARCH FOR COMMON GROUND

A mutual area of connection or agreement. Meet them where they are.



The 4 P's:

- **Passion** (hobbies)
- **Places** (where you live / travel)
- **People** (mutual connections)
- **Present** (what's happening now)

Examples:

- Sports
- Weather
- Fashion
- Food
- And more...

SHARE YOUR TESTIMONY (BURDENS)

Share what God has done in your life that connects with what they may be facing.



- Choose a testimony that resonates
- Let them know you're not perfect
- This removes the pedestal
- It shows God accepts people where they are

5

PROFESSION OF FAITH — THROUGH CONVERSATION

Guide them to sincerely profess faith in Jesus through real conversation.



- Don't force a scripted sinner's prayer
- Genuine agreement counts
- Be intentional
- Clarify that Jesus is the way to God, not just a vague "higher power"

INVITE, INVITE, INVITE — BUILD RELATIONSHIP

Keep building the relationship with consistency.



- Stay consistent with invitations
- Lunch first can be more compelling
- Pray for the relationship and the meal
- Talk about common interests and burdens
- Invite them to church after trust grows
- Church is community, not a one-time visit
- We don't have to pretend we have it all together

Jesus's Template for Living is based on Unconditional Love.. He left the blueprint for the lifestyle that would attract those that are lost...

- Praying For Your enemies



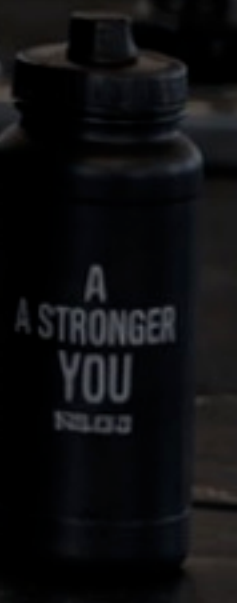

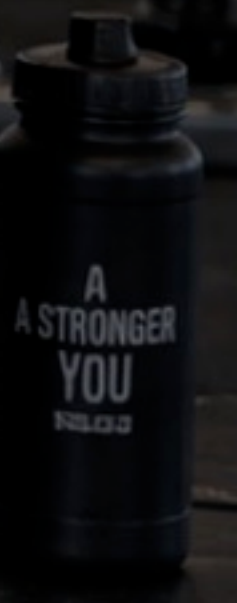
Search For Common Ground

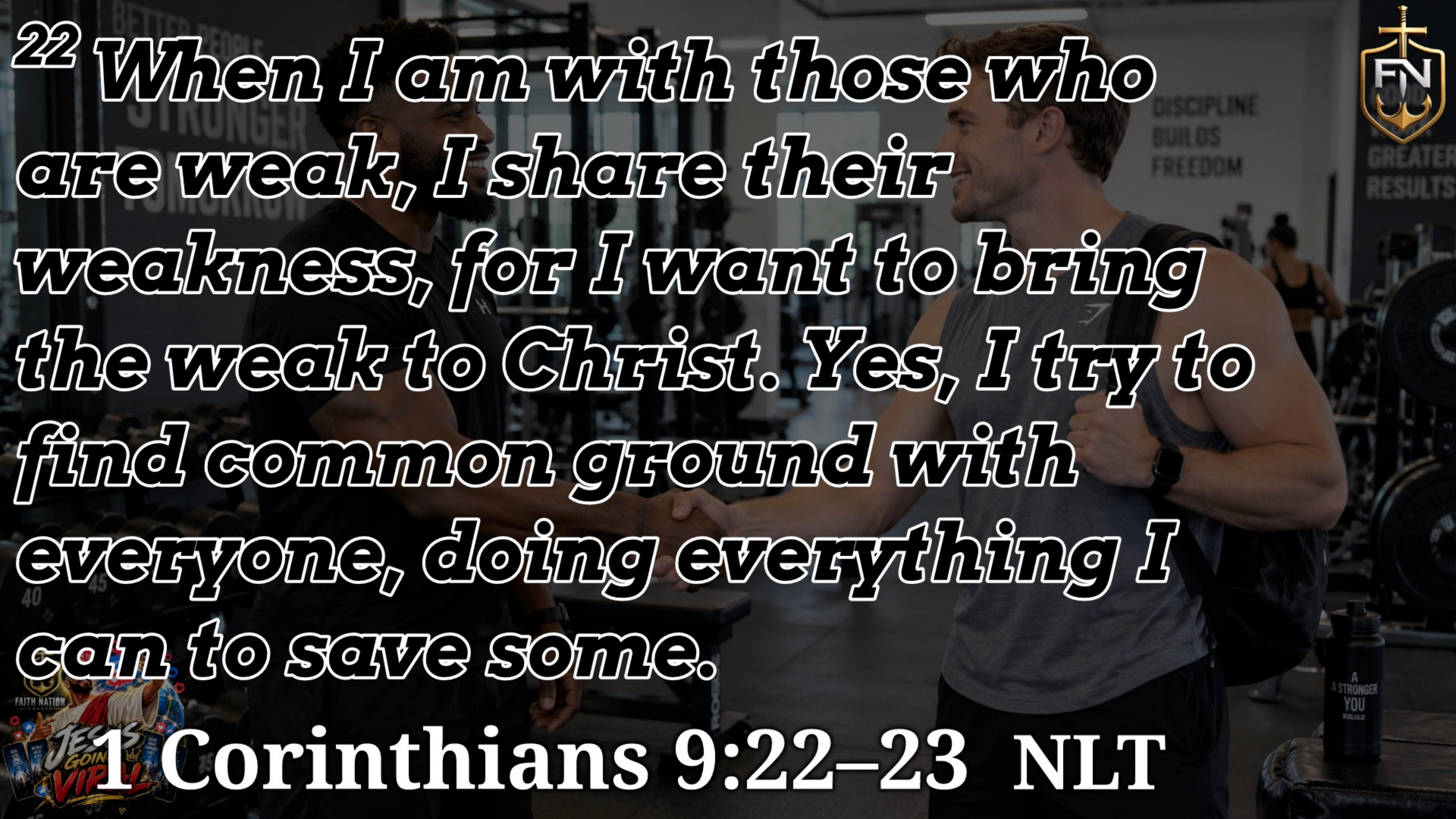


Common Ground: A mutual basis or area of agreement where different people can connect.

4 P's

- 2. Places(Where you live(d) or travel(ed))**
- 3. People(Mutual Connections)**
- 4. Present(What's Happening Now)**

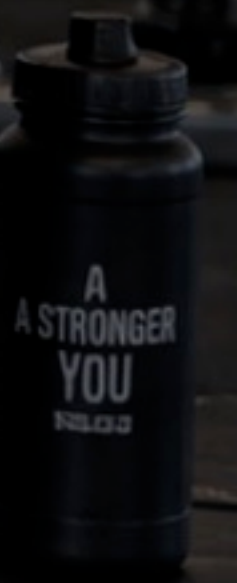

Conversation.

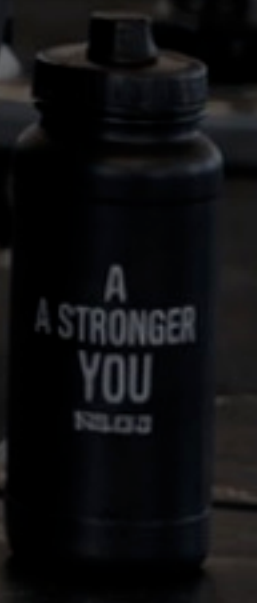

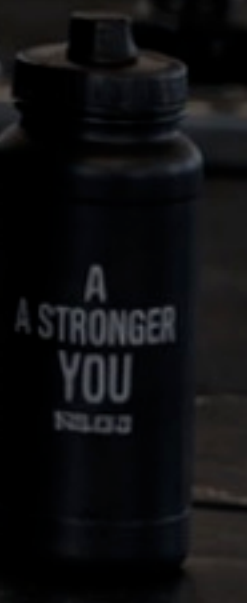
