Keeping Eternity in View

September 6, 2026 | Hebrews 10:32-39

MESSAGE AT A GLANCE

Hebrews 10:32-34	Eternity offers a better possession
Hebrews 10:35-36	Don't throw away your confidence, endure in faith
Hebrews 10:37-38	Christ is coming, so put your faith in Him
Hebrews 10:39	Those who trust Christ, keep eternity in view

MESSAGE SUMMARY

Hebrews 10:32-39 is a call to lift our eyes off what is temporary and look toward what is eternal. The writer of Hebrews does not sugar-coat life. Following Christ and trusting the promises of God is often hard. Sometimes this is because we aren't regularly meditating on the words of Christ. Other times we try to distract ourselves, so we don't have to consider eternity. Living by faith is closely tied to viewing eternity and those who view eternity learn to grow in their faith.

Key Points: We need to keep eternity in view because eternity is coming, this life is fleeting, and current circumstances don't tell the whole story.

CONSIDER THIS WEEK

1. In what ways are you tempted to look at this life more than eternity? Why is this a temptation in your life?
2. Does your life (your relationships, how you spend your energy, your time, or your finances) anchor you to this fleeting life, or do they help you anchor your life to what is eternal?
3. Consider the trials you are walking through right now in your life. What truth of eternity do your trials often cloud out?
4. In what way can a healthy view of eternity shape the way you see your current circumstances?
5. Every believer struggles to keep eternity in view. What are some things that can help you grow in your ability to keep eternity in view on a daily basis?
