- Hebrews 1:14 — "Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?"

The Nearness of God's Presence

God is always present, but there are times when His nearness becomes deeply felt. Like still air becoming wind, we must tune our hearts to sense when God is moving.

Hearing God's Will in Decisions

Bishop Clark shared his story of praying and fasting for direction. He reminded us: God's will is an opportunity, not a guarantee. We must act in obedience.

Three Essentials for Hearing God

The timeless way to hear God: Pray. Fast. Read the Word. These practices position us to hear God's voice and discern His will clearly.

Reflection Question: Which of these three could you grow in most this week?

Prayer as a Lifestyle

Prayer isn't only for certain places. Pray everywhere. Short or long, prayer keeps us aligned with God's Spirit and aware of His leading.

Reflection Question: What's one way you can incorporate prayer into your daily routine?

Using Scripture in Prayer

Using the Lord's Prayer or verses like Ephesians 1 helps structure our prayers. Scripture-based prayer keeps us focused and full of faith.

Reflection Question: What passage could you begin praying this week?

Praying Until Breakthrough

We're called to 'pray through' until we sense peace or movement from heaven. Angels are sent on assignment as we persist in prayer.

Reflection Question: What breakthrough are you still believing God for?

Closing Thought:

Stay connected to the Lord daily. In those quiet moments, His voice brings grace, direction, and strength.

Final Reflection: What one daily habit will help you better hear God's voice this week?
