#### HOW TO STAND FIRM BEYOND THE BATTLE

Timeless Truth: The Lord appoints <u>victory</u> for those who rely upon His faithful love in the midst of their troubles.

Author: David

<u>Royal</u> Psalm - concern either <u>God</u> as King; a <u>human</u> king: or the <u>Messiah</u> King

David's victory over the Ammonites (2 Samuel 12:28-31)

### 4 ANCHORS

1. <u>Find</u> your joy in the Lord's strength both before and beyond the battles (vv 1-6)

Whose victory was it?

Where did David find joy?

Terrain of our battles

Paul's instruction to Timothy (1 Tim 1:18; 6:12; 2 Tim 2:3; 4:7)

Paul's instruction to the church in Thessalonica (1 Thess 5:14-22)

### 5 reasons spiritual battles escalate in our lives:

- If you take significant steps towards spiritual growth
- If you invade enemy territory, such as engaging in God's mission
- If you strive to accurately teach and <u>apply</u> God's Word which exposes Satan's deception and tactics
- If you <u>repent</u> of a long-standing stronghold of sin
- If <u>God</u> is preparing you for a great work for His glory

### 2. <u>Intend</u> to stand firm through your battle because the Lord's faithful love endures forever (v 7)

Intend - to stretch or strain with your mind

hesed - A masculine noun indicating kindness, lovingkindness, mercy, goodness, faithfulness, love, acts of kindness.

# 3. <u>Regain</u> resilience by remembering the Lord's enemies will not prevail (vv 8-12)

The Messianic King who comes to judge

- Isaiah 9:1-7
- Revelation 20:7-10; 11-15
- Psalm 7:11-17

## 4. <u>Magnify</u> the Lord because He appoints victories for those who rely on Him (v 13)
