HOW TO HAVE VICTORY BEFORE WE FACE THE BATTLE

Timeless Truth: The Lord Sustains those who Uphold His Name and Call Out to Him for help in their trouble

Author: David

Royal Psalm - concern either God as King, or the human king

Battle - A fight, or encounter between enemies, or opposing armies; an engagement

David's military campaigns (I Chronicles 18)

What is the terrain of our battles?

4 PRINCIPLES

1. We must unwaveringly uphold God's name prior to our battles (vv 1-3)

How did David uphold God's Name?

How can we uphold God's Name?

2. We must unapologetically express our undivided confidence God is greater than our trouble (vv 4-6)

How did David and the Israelites express their heart's desire for the Lord to fulfill their requests?

What if God doesn't rescue me from a situation where I'm facing trouble because I obey His Word? (Daniel 3)

3. We must <u>boast</u> in our Lord because of His character, reputation, and salvation through His name (vv 7-8)

 $z\bar{a}kar$ – to boast for the purpose to <u>remember</u>, to <u>mention</u>, to make <u>known</u>

Who should we boast about?

Romans 5:2

1 Corinthians 1:31

Philippians 3:3

4. We must <u>depend</u> on the Lord to sustain us and give us victory in our battles (v 9)
