Big Idea: Face the Biblical facts of our sinful portrait that expose our desperate need for the key who is the only One that can set us free.

#### Psalm 14

Exposes the <u>polluted</u> man Portrays the <u>sinner</u>

### Psalm 15

Reveals the <u>perfect</u> man Points to the <u>Savior</u>

## WHAT MUST WE FACE TO LIVE RIGHT WITH GOD?

- 1. Face the facts revealed by the Word (vv 1-3)
  - 4 Biblical facts about sin nature
    - 1) It blinds the mind (2 Corinthians 4:4)
    - 2) It <u>darkens</u> understanding and separates from the life of God (Ephesians 4:17-18)
    - 3) It <u>motivates</u> senseless emotions (Romans 1:18-21)
    - 4) It <u>enslaves</u> the human will to sin against God (Romans 6:20-21)

"All have turned away...all become corrupt...there's no one who is good" – Human <u>Depravity</u>

Total Depravity – "not standing the test" (the test to undo our sin nature and position ourselves to live in right relationship with God based on His holy standard.)



## 2. Face the fact no one can save themselves

## Paul quotes Psalm 14:1-3 in Romans 3:9-12

### Romans 3:13-18

- Throat
- Tongue (Psalm 5:9; 140:3)
- Lips (Psalm 140:3)
- Mouth (Psalm 10:7)
- Feet (Isaiah 59:7-8; Proverbs 1:16)
- Eyes (Psalm 36:1)

Romans 3:19-20 - the law is a spiritual mirror

# 3. Face the fact <u>Jesus Christ</u> is the key

- Romans 3:21-26
- Ephesians 2:4-5

## 4. Embrace the truth Christ is painting (vv 4-7)

If you have believed in the Lord Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior. Psalm 14 is a reminder.

- You are <u>His</u> (v 4)
- He <u>made</u> you righteous (v 5)
- He is your <u>refuge</u> (v 6)
- He is coming to restore His people, and you are invited (v 7)
