Big Idea: As a follower of Jesus, faithfully depend on Him no matter what.

FOUR UNWAVERING CONVICTIONS WE LEARN FROM ISAIAH

1. God's SOVEREIGNTY holds supreme authority over evil rulers (vv 5-11)

God's Sovereignty:

A wrong turn is when a motive is driven by pride and ignores God's purpose.

2. God's AUTHORITY judges all people He uses (vv 12-19)
