THE MENTALITY OF THE WICKED (PSALM 10)

1. He arrogantly thinks, "There's no accountability, since there's no God." (v 4)

2. He says to himself, "I will never be moved—from generation to generation I will be without calamity."

3. He says to himself, "God has forgotten; he hides his face and will never see." (vs. 11)

4. He says to himself, "You (God) will not demand an account." (vs. 13)
