THREE WAYS TO AVOID FALSE TEACHING

1. Concentrate spiritual growth on the <u>reality</u> of who we are in Christ - not what others add (vv 16-17)

Substance -

Christ is the substance, not the shadow

False teaching that spiritually kidnaps people:

Hebrew Roots Movement -

Colossians 2:16-17

Romans 7:6; 14:5

Ephesians 2:15, 19

1 Corinthians 7:18

2. <u>Hold fast</u> to Christ who grows our faith - not spiritual mysticisms (vv 18-19)

"condemn" - <i>katabrabeúsō</i> , from <i>katá</i> , against, and
$brabe\acute{u}\bar{o}$, to be a judge or umpire and thus award the prize
in a public game.

- 3 Errors legalistic mystics pressure people for spiritual growth:
 - (1) False visions
 - (2) Human arrogance
 - (3) Reject holding to Christ
- 3. <u>Belong</u> to Christ so we live a biblical worldview not a dogmatic order (vv 20-23)
