3 WAYS TO STAY IN ALIGNMENT WITH GOD'S PROMISE

1. Long for the Lord's righteousness and salvation to shine as He promised it will in His future kingdom (vv 1-5)

Zion – “God’s Chosen Location for His People”

Jerusalem - “Height or Foundation of Peace”; city of peace; the Holy City (Isa. 52:1)

What will the world say about Israel at Christ's second coming?

What did the Lord say He will call Israel?

Hephziah (My delight is in her) & Beulah (Married one)

What should we say about Israel until Christ Returns?

We are Ambassadors of Reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:20-21)

Stand against antisemitism

- Followers of Jesus have Jewish roots (Romans 11:16)
- We have a Jewish Redeemer, Jesus the Messiah (Romans 9:4-5)
- Paul calls the Lord Jesus a “descendent of David” (Romans 1:3; 2 Timothy 2:8)
- We will stand before a Jewish Judge (2 Corinthians 5:10)
