### THOMAS' STRUGGLE (John 20:24-25)

Why had Thomas convinced himself he would never believe Jesus' resurrection unless he saw Him?

If you've been struggling like Thomas this past week,

- \_\_\_\_\_ from the fear of that dark tomb and face Jesus like Mary did – He knows your name
- \_\_\_\_\_ that long road you're on with Jesus and listen to Him like the two disciples on the road to Emmaus – He will only tell you the truth
- \_\_\_\_\_ with other believers even when things are uncertain like the disciples – He will show up through His Word

### WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN JESUS SHOWS UP? (v.26-27)

1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ He is trustworthy (*Luke 18:31-33*)
2. Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ remain forever (*Matt. 24:35; Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33*)
3. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ over your crisis of belief (John 20:27)
