Feeds Her Family - Proverbs 31:15 She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens.



She Clothes Her Family - Proverbs 31:19 She layeth her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff. (Laundry)



She Prepares for Her Family - Proverbs

31:21-22 She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household are clothed with scarlet. (22) She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing is silk and purple.



She Works for Her Family - Proverbs 31:27-

29 She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. (28) Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her. (29) Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all.

1 Samuel 1:20 Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name Samuel, saying, Because I have asked him of the LORD.

1 Samuel 1:27-28 For this child I prayed; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him: **(28) Therefore also I have lent him to the LORD; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshipped the LORD there.**

We also thank God for the mothers who may not be mothers biologically, but have stepped up to the plate and treated the younger women as children.

1 Timothy 5:2 The elder women as mothers; the younger as sisters, with all purity.

Titus 2:3-5 The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; (4) That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to

love their children, (5) To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.
