3. Biblical Music

- Psalms is 7% of OT
- Not including Other wisdom books and thematic throughout the story.

4. Sprit-Filled and in Order

- John 4:21-24, 1 Cor. 14:26-40, Neh. 9:3 (Planned prayer and reading), Eph. 5:18-21

5. Blended (Kinds of Songs in the Bible)

- Praise for deliverance (Ex 15:2ff, 2Sam 22:1, 23:1; 1Kgs. 1:39)
- Songs to other Gods (which is a negative example) (Exod. 32:17 Golden Calf, Dan. 3:1ff Nebuchadnezzar)
- Proclaiming the Name of the Lord (Duet. 32:1ff, Psalm 8, 9, 13, 18)
- Creation songs (Psalm 19, 21, 22, 27)
- Attributes of God
- Strength, Salvation, a Resting Place, What he Does and Who he is.
- Prophetic songs that accompanied the Prophets (1sam 10:5, 2KGS 3:14)
- Songs of relief (David to Saul 1 Sam 15:15)
- Praise for Hero's in Battle (1 Sam 18:5, 19:8, 21:10, 29:4; 2Sam 3:32)
- A Choir in battle (2 Chr. 20:20-29, 2 Ch23:12ff)
- Celebration before the Lord (2Sam 6:3, 19:34)
- Lament (Psalm 3,13,22,77)
- Thanksgiving (e.g. Psalm 18, 30)
- Praise (e.g. Psalm 29, 47, 96, 98, 146-150)
- Others include confidence, kingship, remembrance, wisdom, remembrance, and dedication, ascension.

6. Davidic Worship: Tabernacle and Temple

- 4000 member Choir and Orchestra (1Chr. 23:4ff, 25:1ff)
- Specific Priests set as Musicians (2Chr. 5:12-14, 2Chr 7:5-6, 2Chr 9:10-11, 2 Chr, 15:14)
- Skilled Musicians (1Chr. 15, 25; 2Chr. 34:12-35:27, Ezra 2:40ff, 70, 3:10ff, 7:6ff)
- Singers didn't need to pay Temple Tax (Ezra 7:24ff, 10:24, Neh. 7:1, 7:44ff, Neh. 10:28ff, Neh. 11:22ff)

7. Kinds of Instruments

- Shofars, Trumpets, Flutes, Pipes, Harp, Lute, Lyre, Bells, Cymbals, Gongs, Drums

8. Things that we should expect from Biblical Worship

- Singing (e.g. Ps. 100, 95, Col 3:16)
- Clapping Hands (2 Kgs. 11, Ps. 47, 98, Isa. 55)
- Dancing (e.g. Ex. 15, Ps. 30, Jdg. 11, 21)
- Shouting and Loud Music (e.g. Ps. 81, 95, 98, Isa. 12:4-6, Zeph. 3:14)
- Hands Raised (e.g. 1 Kings 8:54, Neh. 8:6, Ps. 28, 1 Tim. 2:8-10)
- New Songs (e.g. Ps. 33, 40, 96, 98, 149, Isa. 42, Rev. 5:9, 14:3)
- Edification of the Body of Believers (1 Cor. 14:26-39)
