What is God's first emotional posture toward us, and how does that make you feel about yourself and others?

Sermon Questions

Read Genesis 1:1–5

- When you think about how God relates to the world, do you instinctively picture distance, evaluation, or goodness?

Read Genesis 1:27

- If God delights in humanity as His image-bearers before performance or failure, what most often shapes how you see yourself instead?

Read Genesis 1:28–31

- God declares creation “very good” and remains committed to what He has made.
- How does this shape the way you understand God’s emotional posture toward you today?

Read Psalm 104 31 and Psalm 16 11

- God rejoices in His works and invites us into His presence.
- How does knowing God’s delight is faithful, not indulgent, change the way you approach Him?

Nation: Congo

- Pray for a pure Gospel to be proclaimed that is devoid of syncretism and heresy.
- Pray for the Church to recapture the vision for evangelism of the entire country.
