Sermon Questions

Read 2 Samuel 12:1-7a

- Where do you tend to see sin clearly in others but not in yourself?
- How might God be trying to reveal something in you right now?

Read 2 Samuel 12:7b-14

- How do you usually respond when you are confronted?
- What would it look like to see God's correction as care, not rejection?

Read Psalm 51:1-12

- Do you tend to respond to sin with shame or repentance?
- What would it mean for you to ask God for a "clean heart" this week?

Read 2 Samuel 12:15-23

- How does this passage shape your view of consequences and forgiveness?
- Why is it important to hold together both restoration and seriousness about sin?

When you are angry, does it move toward restoration or destruction?

What is one situation this week where you can choose a restorative response?
