Psalm 107:33-42 Reversal

Growth Group study questions:

- Read Psalm 107:1-3
 - Say together the first verse.
 - Was that a struggle or did it feel good?
- Read Psalm 107:4-9; Matt 5:1-6; John 4:7-15, 6:31-40, 7:37-39
 - What is it like to wander? not feel settled?
 - Do you cry out to the lord when you are lost?
 - Talk about a time where God made things right.
- Read Psalm 107:10-16, Luke 13:10-17; Acts 12:7
 - What does it feel like to be in darkness? Misery?
 - Why does this happen? Is there a way out?
 - Talk about a time God set you free from darkness.
- Read Psalm 107:17-22
 - Talk about a time you were rebellious.
 - How did it work out for you? Did the Lord save you?
- Read Psalm 107:17-22; James 1:5-6; Luke 8:22-25
 - What does it feel like to be tossed by life?
 - What can the Lord do?
