Sermon Questions

Read Isaiah 62:1-5

- Why is it hard to believe God delights in restoring people?
- Which image speaks to you most?

Read Isaiah 1:1-9

- Where have you stopped expecting restoration?
- How would prayer change if it became participation in God's joy?

Read Isaiah 1:1-9

- Have you experienced an interruption that became an intervention?
- What stones keep people from returning to God?

What would change if you truly believed God rejoices in restoring you?

Nation: Laos
