- What type do you struggle with the most?

Read Eph 5:7-13; Dan 2:20-22

- How do we do “active goodness”?
- Who changes things and reveals hidden things?

Read Eph 5:14-21; Isa 60:1-3; John 1:1-10

- So what do we need to do?
- Who is the light? Can hide things from the Light?
- What is our job concerning the light?
