

THEOLOGY OF GROWTH

Rabbi Jacob Rosenberg

What does Scripture say we are supposed to do when God grows His people?

Sermon Questions

Read Acts 6:1-7. Growth did not create sin; it exposed strain

- When strain shows up, what is your first instinct: to pull back, push harder, or pause and reassess?
- What thoughts or assumptions tend to surface for you when things no longer feel simple?

Read Exodus 18:17-27. When God grows His people, He does not shrink the community. He expands leadership.

- What comes to mind for you when you think about leadership being shared or expanded?
- What do you think helps or hinders trust in leadership for people?

Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-20. Growth does not mean everyone does more. It means everyone does their part.

- Where do you sense God may be inviting you to contribute in a way that fits who you are, not who you think you should be?

Read Matthew 25:14-30. The servant was not judged for being given less, but for burying what was entrusted out of fear.

- What concerns or hesitations tend to make people hold back when responsibility increases?
- Where do you notice hesitation competing with trust in your own life?

Nation: Peru

- Pray for a return to peace and stability after decades of corruption, dictatorships, and terror.
- Pray for humble pastors trained in Biblical theology who reflect Yeshua
- Pray for Christians to boldly oppose sin and injustice while also ministering to the poor and oppressed.
- Pray that this nation would grow in support for the redemption of Israel.

Israel and Hamas

- Pray as a regrouping of Hamas and Hezbollah has started.
- Pray for the spiritual and emotional recovery of all those involved or affected in the war.
- Pray, as there is a rise in anti-semitism around the world
