Sermon Questions

Read 1 Samuel 1:10-28; Luke 1:26-45

- How are the two openings similar? Different?

Read 1 Samuel 2:1-2; Deut. 32:30-31; Luke 1:46-47 (Praise).

- What does the news cause them to do?
- What is the object of their joy?

Read 1 Samuel 2:2-3; Luke 1:48-50; Psalm 103 (Humility).

- Why does our faith remain humble?

Read 1 Samuel 2:4-5,7-8; Luke 1:51-53 (Reversal).

- How does God reverse our circumstances?
- What is the ultimate way?

Read 1 Samuel 2:6-9, 9-10; Luke 1:50-53 (Justice).

- Who is the one who chooses?

Read 1 Samuel 2:10-11; Deut. 17:15; Gen 49:10-12; Luke 1:54-55 (Future Covenant).

- Since Israel had no king at the time, what was Hannah echoing?
- How did the first-century people seem to understand 1 Samuel 2:10-11? How does Mary understand what is happening and what will happen?

How can faith based in praise, humility, reversal, justice, and the birth of Yeshua change the way you live your life?
